Won of Fourteen - Sentry ToC Edition

Gear enthusiasts and weekend warriors alike often wonder what clubs the pros are gaming each week. This series of articles will focus on one of the fourteen clubs that captured my attention and helped propel your favorite PGA Tour player to victory this past weekend.

This week, Jon Rahm took home the trophy at the Sentry Tournament of Champions after trailing by seven strokes entering the final round. Let's take a look at the recently released driver from Callaway that helped him secure his 8th PGA Tour victory!

Callaway Paradym Drivers



If you're Callaway Golf, you couldn't script a better week as your number one brand ambassador puts your new driver in play at the Sentry Tournament of Champions, overcomes a seven shot deficit, and takes home the title. Add to that, his +1.74 strokes gained off the tee led the field in the

final round where he also hit 60% of his fairways and averaged 333.6 yards off the tee.

Safe to say there are a lot of smiles inside the Callaway Golf campus in Carlsbad, California on this Monday morning, for sure. As the ball dropped and the calendar turned to 2023, the Callaway line on Paradym drivers hit the USGA Conforming List offering multiple variations (Paradym, Paradym X, and Paradym Triple Diamond) to suit every golfer's swing and tendencies.

Let's get in to the main features of the new Paradym drivers:

• Industry first 360° carbon chassis resulting in a body that's 44% lighter than an all-titanium body. This massive weight savings is repositioned both forward to enhance ball speed, and toward the back of the clubhead for increased forgiveness.

- New A.I. designed Jailbreak system is 33% lighter than its predecessor, enhancing stability and ball speeds. Jailbreak A.I. is designed to increase stiffness in the body for more face flex and higher ball speeds.
- New A.I. designed face optimized to increase ball speeds, enhance launch, and now downrange dispersion. Experience a more consistent shot pattern with the world's most advanced driver face designed by A.I.
- Three distinct Paradym driver models, each with their own unique ability to dial in ball flight for the golfer's swing.
