

2023 Dove Tree Pool Rules & Policies

As a community we pay for the privileges to use the pool and tennis courts. In order to maintain the safest, cleanest, most family friendly facilities, we need everyone's cooperation in following these guidelines.

- Every Dove Tree Member and Associate household in good standing will be given Smartphone Access for 2 devices and 1 Physical Key Fob. Extra Key Fobs can be purchased for an additional \$10 by contacting the HOA.
- Each time you visit the pool, you must enter by either using your Smartphone App or Key Fob. Key Fobs are meant to be shared within households only, DO NOT give your Key Fob to any guests or any child under the age of 10.
- Guests are welcome for a fee of \$2 per guest, all guest fees can be given to the lifeguard upon arrival. No more than 10 guests at a time, this includes adults and children.
- If you have more than 10 guests, you must rent the clubhouse and/or obtain additional lifeguards, for more info see rental agreement posted on the website.
- During Lifeguarded hours, the lifeguard is primarily responsible for the safety of all swimmers in the water. Please monitor your child and/or children. The lifeguard is ***not a babysitter***.
- In order to participate in early swim and swim at your own risk hours, you must complete the online Early Swim Waiver.
- Children that are 10 years old (and/or rising 5th grader) may be at the pool without a guardian when at least one lifeguard is on duty. This is contingent on the swimmer completing the Lifeguard conducted swim test to ensure swimming ability.
- As a safety precaution, a fifteen-minute rest period(adult swim) will be observed each hour.
- Everyone entering the pool must wear the proper swimming attire.
- Swim diapers must be worn by those not potty trained.
- NO running, pushing, wrestling, snapping towels, noodle fighting, or causing undue disturbance around the pool or bathroom areas. Horseplay will not be tolerated.

- NO playing around or hanging from the lifeguard stands. No diving or jumping off the lifeguard stands.
- Food should be kept at least ten feet from the edge of the pool. Please use the proper trash containers provided.
- NO Tobacco products on the pool deck.
- NO pets or animals are permitted on the pool deck or tennis courts. Pets in other recreational areas must be contained on a leash.
- NO children are allowed in the baby pool without ADULT supervision. This pool is for children ages 4 and under.
- NO diving in the shallow end of the pool.
- Floats are ONLY permitted in the shallow end unless otherwise determined by the lifeguard.
- NO bicycles, skateboards, skates, roller blades, scooters, etc. are allowed in the clubhouse area, pool deck, or on the tennis courts at any time.
- No pop up tents are allowed on the pool deck.
- **NO GLASS** allowed on the pool deck.
- NO weapon of any form will be allowed on Dove Tree Recreational Property.
- Any blatant disregard for a Lifeguard's authority or any of the pool rules and regulations will result in that person's immediate removal from the pool.
 - First offense: 1 hr time out of the pool
 - Second offense: sent out of the pool for the remainder of the day
 - Third offense: 3 days out of the pool.
 - All offenses are determined at the Lifeguards discretion.
- Be mindful of other swimmers and seek to ensure that everyone has an enjoyable time at the pool, ie. limit the use of water guns, loud or offensive music and games like chicken fighting and wrestling.
- **You are responsible for your child and/or children's behavior and compliance with pool rules. If at any time these rules and policies are not followed, your pool access (smartphone & key fob) can be revoked.**
