Our travel program is designed to provide a positive experience for players capable and interested in advanced level of play. GENERAL INFORMATION

*Teams will practice a minimum of 1-2 days a week.

*Primary Practice locations:

Dean Road Rec (335 S Dean RD, Auburn, Al, Frank brown Rec (235 Opelika RD, Auburn, AL), and CTA@MAX (189 East University Dr, Auburn, AL).

Additional locations may be added to accommodate travel needs of players and coaches.

*Tournaments will begin EARLY APRIL and are listed on www.thesilverbackz.com under AAU Basketball. We expect to compete in a minimum of 7 tournaments for the Spring/Summer session. Additional tournaments may be added as season progresses.

*Players are expected to attend ALL practices and tournament. If a player is unable to attend a practice/game, he is required to notify his head coach at least 24 hour prior to scheduled practice or game. Emergencies will be considered.

Player Fee Breakdown:

\$275 Registration Fee

Registration fees cover uniform rental and maintenance, team player pack, team membership (for associations such as AAU) and other miscellaneous expenses (banking fees, marketing, equipment, coach's apparel, and expenses).

\$125 Practice Facility Usage/Rental Fee

Includes 15 weeks of practice and training.

\$125 Tournament Fee

(DOES NOT include fees for National Tournaments)

AAU Tournament entry fees went from \$300 to this season range from \$350-\$425.

Player fees DO NOT include travel expenses.



PARENT AND PLAYER CONTRACT

FINANCIAL COMMITMENT

PLAYER FEES

Player Fees cover court rental fees, trainer fees, equipment fees, uniforms, fees, tournament fees and other miscellaneous fees teams may incur throughout the season.

Player fees will be payable as outlined above. Installment options available and must be kept ensuring AAU program is financially supported.

Player fees must be received by the due date or player will not be permitted to practice or participate in any tournaments. If a player is overly delinquent in player fee, he or she will be removed from our rosters.

REFUND POLICY

NO refunds will be granted after a player has committed to the team/season.

There is no refund for quitting the team at any point during the season.

Any payment concerns or discrepancies must be made in writing to the director.

Limited financial assistance is available for players who can show a financial need. Please contact director to complete a financial assistance application. Applications must be submitted prior to first scheduled practice to be considered. A limited number of scholarships are available and will be given on a first come basis.

FUNDRAISERS

Families are required to participate in all mandatory fundraisers. Proceeds from our fundraisers are used to offset travel expense such as lodging, meals as well as unexpected expenses that may arise throughout the season. We have 2 planned mandatory fundraisers for our Spring/Summer 2020 season. Families may “opt out” completely from participating in our fundraisers by paying a \$125 “opt out” fee per fundraiser. Fundraiser “opt out” fee is due when fundraisers are due.

PRACTICE

Travel basketball is a huge commitment for players and parents. The only way to improve is to attend practice. If you are unable to attend practice, please notify your coach 24 hours prior to scheduled practice. Players who do not attend practices will see their playing time diminish. Repeated missed practices may result in dismissal from the program.

COACHES

We are proud of our coaching staff. Their goals are to play and to win while developing individual skills, enhancing chemistry, and improving each player's knowledge of the game. Playing time will vary according to team and is not guaranteed. Playing time is earned through performance both at practice and during games. Each team member will enter at least one game during a tournament. All other playing time is determined by the coach and is non-negotiable.

Every team wants to win, and in a competitive travel tournament, the coach will play the players required to help the team perform best.

Parents are NOT permitted to confront the coaches during tournaments to discuss playing time, tactics, individual, or team performance. If there are questions or concerns that need to be discussed, please set up an appointment with the coach privately. We are more than willing to discuss any parent concerns in an appropriate time and place.

TOURNAMENTS

All tournaments are tentatively scheduled and subject to change for various reasons. We make all attempts to stick to our tournaments as scheduled however sometimes changes are inevitable. If there are changes to our tournament schedule, we will notify you as soon as possible. We will make all efforts to reschedule/replace any cancelled tournaments.

Most tournaments are either 1-day, 2-day or a 3-day event. Most 1-day events take place on Saturday, 2-day events cover both Saturday and Sunday, and some large tournaments stretch across Friday evening, Saturday and Sunday.

EACH TOURNAMENT WILL MAKE THEIR OWN SCHEDULE AND HAVE THEIR OWN RULES. Each tournament will also require daily/weekend admission fees that typically range \$10-\$30.



Exact game schedules are often not available until the Thursday evening prior to tournament weekend. This is due to team withdrawals, changes, late entries as well as unforeseen issues, all of which affect the number of games, schedule, and match ups. Please understand that there is always the possible of last-minute schedule changes and we will update you as changes occur.

We have no control over when game schedules are posted but will get game times to you as soon as they are provided to us.

Tournaments, like practices, are required for all players. Players are expected to inform coaches at the earliest possible time if they must miss a tournament or game.

OPPONENTS

Players and parents will show respect to our opponents. Our program will play (win or lose) with class and dignity. Players will shake hands and congratulate opponents after a game. Our players will help an opponent off the floor. Our players will maintain a positive attitude in any communication with opponents.

REFEREES

Referees have a difficult job to do and are to be treated with respect. Players and parents will accept all calls "move past" what they consider to be questionable and play on. A player that argues a call will immediately be removed from the game. A parent that argues a call will be asked to stop and will be asked to leave the gym if the unsporting conduct continues. Coaches will be the only representatives talking to the officials.

OFF THE COURT

Players and Parents agree to hold themselves to these same high standards off the court. Players agree and understand that academics and family responsibilities come first. We expect all players to maintain at least a "C" average in all subjects.

Disparaging remarks about teammates, coaches or opponents will not be permitted. (This includes any social media.) Participating in the DSB Basketball program is a privilege. This privilege can be revoked because of any conduct considered to be detrimental to players, families or DSB Basketball Program.



UNIFORM POLICY

Uniforms are an extension of our program and should be worn properly. Jersey tucked in for games, shooter shirt worn during warmups, and bags placed behind bench.

DSB BASKETBALL Volunteer and Fundraising Out Form

DSB Basketball relies on fundraising and volunteering to keep registration costs at a minimum and help our coaches with hotels / gas for volunteering their time to coach. Without successful fundraisers, our player fees would almost double. For our Spring 2024 season, we will require 2 mandatory fundraisers and 2 mandatory volunteer assignments.
