Time to spend with our family, friends and tonight, with each other as we enjoy some of our holiday favorites. I want to take a moment to thank you, our loyal patrons who continue to support us with your presence and financial support. Our concert this evening celebrates the season with the Winds performing some of our very favorite holiday arrangements. Many of you will be hearing either the Winds and/or our guest artists for the first time. Welcome!

The first half of tonight's concert opens with a fanfare arrangement of two perennial holiday favorites, "O Come, All Ye faithful and Joy to the World". We turn to the music of local composer Stephen Melillo, in an awe inspired arrangement of "Of Come Holy Night". We are thrilled to welcome the angelic voices of the children's choir from Old Donation School, Brickell Academy for Advanced Academics and Arts, under the direction of Ashley Adams and Sue Davis. 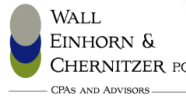

**Band-Together** is a pilot program that provides instrumental music instruction for individuals with and without disabilities on traditional band instruments (flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, percussion.) Taught by Ms. Karen Jackson and Ms. Beckie Jones, both veteran band teachers with experience with people with disabilities, the program offers individual or small group lessons and a weekly evening ensemble rehearsal..

The objectives of the Band-Together pilot program are to:

- Provide a high level of instrumental music instruction for individuals of all abilities.
- Give individuals with disabilities the opportunity to learn a band instrument.
- Teach group cooperation, team work and ensemble playing skills.
- Bring people in the community together to perform and enjoy music, supporting each other in an ensemble experience.

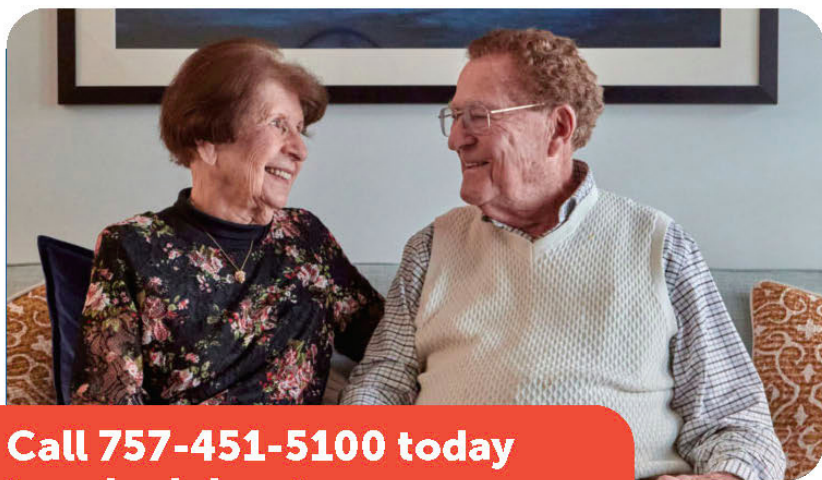
