I will both lie down and sleep in peace, for you alone, O Lord, make me lie down in safety. (Psalm 4:8)

This verse, as well as other biblical verses about rest and sleep, are very appealing to me. Because I am not a good sleeper, and have never been consistent in my sleeping. The past few years have found me either sleeping too much or hardly at all. I especially find Saturday nights troublesome, as I know I have to get up early Sunday morning and that seems to lead to all kinds of insomniac behavior and a far from good Sunday morning.

So it is with joy that I found this writing by French poet and philosopher Charles Peguy (1873-1914), who went from being an agnostic to becoming a faithful Catholic in 1908. This free verse poem gives me joy and hope that maybe I can find a better way to spend my nights than tossing and turning! I pray you find value in it as well.



God Speaks by Charles Peguy

I don't like the man who doesn't sleep, says God.

Sleep is the friend of man.

Sleep is the friend of God.

Sleep is perhaps the most beautiful thing I have created.

And I myself rested on the seventh day.

He whose heart is pure, sleeps. And he who sleeps has a pure

That is the great secret of being as indefatigable as a child.

Of having that strength in the legs that a child has.

Those new legs, those new souls,

And to begin afresh every morning, ever new,

Like young hope, new hope ...

He who doesn't sleep is unfaithful to Hope.

And it is the great infidelity.

Because it is infidelity to the greatest Faith.

Poor children, they conduct their business with wisdom during the day.

But when evening comes, they can't make up their minds, They can't be resigned to trust my wisdom for the space of one night

With the conduct and the governing of their business.

As if I wasn't capable, if you please, of looking after it a little. Of watching over it.

Of governing and conducting, and all that kind of stuff.
I have a great deal more business to look after, poor people

I govern creation, maybe that is more difficult.

You might perhaps, and no harm done, leave your business in my hands, O wise men.

Maybe I am just as wise as you are.

You might perhaps leave it for me for the space of a night.

While you are asleep

At last

And the next morning; you might find it not too badly damaged perhaps ...

Put off until tomorrow those tears which fill your eyes and your head,

Flooding you, rolling down your cheeks, those tears which stream down your cheeks.

Because between now and tomorrow, maybe I, God, will have passed by your way.

Human wisdom says: Woe to the man who puts off what he has to do until tomorrow.

And I say Blessed, blessed is the man who puts off what he has to do until tomorrow.

Blessed is he who puts off. That is to say Blessed is he who hopes. And who sleeps.

If you have gotten through to this point, you have earned a nap!



Investing in Epiphany Lutheran Church

If You Are Over 72

As many of you know, if you have an IRA investment account and you are over 72 you are required to take a minimum distribution from that account each year. What you might not be aware of is that you can make contributions to any charitable organization from this distribution and those contributions are tax exempt. It is excellent way to make a contribution to Epiphany. You should check with your investment advisor and find out how you can take advantage of this benefit.

At Any Age

If you have an investment portfolio with significant gains, ask your financial advisor about setting up a charitable donor-advised fund. You can transfer stock, mutual funds, etc. directly to it without paying capital gains and that transfer counts as a charitable contribution for your itemized deductions. Many investment companies sponsor donor-advised charitable funds (e.g., Fidelity, Schwab, Vanguard); some banks (such as Bank of America) offer them as well. You can then manage this donor-advised fund to donate to charities (including Epiphany) whenever you want.


