Sunny Jim releases new album Changing Tides

The record, his 11th self-published studio project, includes 13 original songs that reflect the highs and lows he has experienced during the past couple of years. The loss of both his beloved father and his best friend, and the isolation of the Covid lockdown inspired "Waiting for the Tide."



Sunny Jim made the best of the lockdown by

broadcasting weekly livestream shows from his home studio in Osprey, FL with friend and steel drum player John Patti, to keep working and stay connected with fans. The shows gained a great local and international following, and the studio became known as the "Cantina Jaime del Sol." James was motivated to write the song "Cantina Jaime del Sol" which became a signature welcome for viewers.

Time spent at home with family and pets during Covid inspired "Home is Where the Palm Trees Grow." After things got back to normal and he once again performed for live audiences filled with fans and friends, Sunny Jim co-wrote the song "Friendships" with Austin songwriter Dan Sullivan.

"The CD as a whole – the complete creative process of making it – has been an uplifting experience," said James White. "The pure joy of creation; writing the music, collaborating with others, and then recording it, is what makes me happy."

"Each song is different in its styling, arrangement, and theme. *Changing Tides* will take you on a musical journey through Key West, Cuba, Mexico, the South Pacific, and even Ireland," said Radio Troprock's Eric Babin. The CD should come packaged with a warning: "Don't push play unless you are prepared to listen beginning to end. It's difficult to push 'stop' once you start."
