IMPORTANT! INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING MARKING PACKAGE

The North Central South Zone Mine Rescue Competition tasks are normally hosted by opposite zone teams/companies (North teams host Central South Teams and visa versa). This package establishes standard marking procedures and assists the adjudicators in the tally process.

This form is a standard MS Word document which can be easily edited. DO NOT change or edit the Captains Performance Marks. The overall task summary sheet can be edited with add on or remove sheet(s) or add on or remove patient sheet(s), but format must stay the same.

DEFINITIONS

TASK: The Mine Rescue Competition is made up of separate tasks which may or may not be combined, determined at the Association meeting prior to the competition. Currently tasks are: Fire/Smoke -- Rope/Field - Bench/Written - Mine rescue First Aid (no actual separate field task - points are pulled and used for final team overall competition score but the actual field marking is "within" the 3 combination tasks noted).

NOTE: ZONE 3 Person First Aid is a complete separate competition.

SPECIAL NOTE: BENCH/WRITTEN The total points for the task will be the same as other combination tasks. <u>DO NOT USE Captain Performance Marking sheet here</u>. The bench portion will still include First Aid component 25% of total marks.

COMPONENT: The host/task designer describes a component of the task. Examples; Donning SCBA, building entry, rope system, fire attack etc.

ITEM: Items are the individual items for the judge to mark on. Examples; Entry into building in a safe manner, ensuring no danger, control of bleed, equipment handling, check gas readings, check radial pulse etc.

POINTS AVAILABLE: Points available are assigned for each item. Host/task designer must ensure this column per sheet including Overall Task Summary sheet is filled in.

POINTS AWARDED: Amount of points awarded by judge for each item.

NOTE: Task host/designer can include penalty deduction points (minus) for safety or equipment handling infractions. It must be CLEARLY marked on the scoring sheet so it won't be mistaken for awarded points.

TASK SHEET PACKAGE: Host/designer must submit package to the ZONE CHIEF TASK JUDGE by deadline date determined at the Association meeting. If changes are made, the newer version must be submitted to the ZONE CHIEF TASK JUDGE prior to competition day.

MARKING SHEETS

- PAGE 1: Is the marking package cover page with option to add introduction comments to each team or team Captain.
- PAGES 2 5: Listed as pages "A, B, C, D". These are the marking sheets
 to be edited, items can be shorter, longer or even split. The font can be
 changed for space. Number of pages can be reduced, ensure any changes
 are put on Overall Task Summary Sheet. NOTE Presently 4 PAGES, THIS
 SHOULD BE THE MAXIMUM for adjudication tally time controls.
 NOTE: Exception option at written/bench task Individual marking sheets
 per team member.
- PAGE 6: Listed as page "E" Optional marking sheet for overall team points not covered under Captains marks.
- PAGE 7: LISTED AS "CAPTAINS PERFORMANCE MARKS". <u>DO NOT CHANGE OR EDIT THIS SHEET</u> (STANDARD MARKING). The Captain's marks are form 10% of total 600 = 60 points (2007 rule).
- PAGES 8 AND 9: Listed as pages "F & G". These are for the first aid component of the task which is 25% of total 600 = 150 points (2007 rule). These the same as other sheets. OPTION: You can reduce to 1 patient or add more patients, ensure changes are put on Overall Task Summary sheet.
- PAGE 10: Overall Task Summary for the adjudicators for overall competition marks. The host/task designer must fill in possible points for each page and ensure they match.
- PAGE 11 Snap shot of task expectations. Please complete to ensure Chief Task Judge has an understanding of the overall objectives and requirements for the task.
- Option: Host/task designers can add a Spectator sheet for Handing out. Ensure the information is "very generic". Copies may become lost and found in inappropriate locations. Example: Washroom shared by competitors and spectators.

All task points: Do not deter from points allocated (2007 rule), the Adjudicators do not have the time to check factors etc.:

- 600 Overall
- 60 (10%) Captain Marks
- 150 (25%) First Aid Marks

JUDGE MARKING

In recent years, the competition scores have been getting tighter and there have been minor mistakes in marking that can influence the placing of a team in the overall scoring.

To ensure no confusion and timely compilation of scores for adjudicators, Host Task Judges must review the following with all personnel judging/marking:

- Fill in description of team competing and hosts sections.
- Every item must have points awarded, if zero mark "0" No blanks.
- Any points awarded less than available or not awarded must have a comment such as "not done' "incomplete" "late", do not use N/A N/G etc.
- Comments column: Good comments are as important as bad ones, the competition is a learning environment. Please print.
- Any scores "outside" of Points Awarded column will NOT be used.
- If changes from original sheet, change must be clearly indicated and initialed. EXAMPLE: Task sheet marking item: Proper anchor used to tree and upon day of competition tree not available, pickup substituted. Ensure changes are the same for every marking package used.

DO NOT ADD TOTALS IN THE FIELD!

- Sub totals OK for field marking. Time to add totals in field tends to slow rotation and if total does not match points awarded, the adjudicators must sort out confusion.
- Marking Judge is to initial sheet, if there are any questions the adjudicators can send back the right marker for clarification.
- IMPORTANT! Host Task Judges to check that "each" item has a point awarded mark!
- Ensure all sheets are accounted for and have ready ASAP, there will be runners assigned to pick up marking packages from each task site and take to adjudicators.
