Following the announcement of the first convention – SatanCon 2022 that will take place February 11-13, 2022 in Scottsdale, Arizona, the Office of the Bishop for the Diocese of Phoenix released a memo, (attached). In the statement released January 14, 2022, Bishop Olmsted said, "I ask the faithful of the Diocese to refrain from organizing or participating in any type of protest at the venue of the Convention. Instead, in our spiritual warfare against Satan and his minions; prayer, fasting, reparation and sacrifices coupled with the Sacraments are the most effective, spiritual weapons at our disposal."
