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PART 1 - GENERAL

1.01 RELATED DOCUMENTS

A. Drawings and general provisions of the Contract, including General and Supplementary Conditions and Division 01 Specification Sections, apply to this Section.

1.02 SUMMARY

- A. This Section includes the following:
 - 1. Tackable Wall System.

1.03 DESCRIPTION OF WORK

A. Provide all labor, materials and services required to properly and completely install tackable wall panels as specified herein and as indicated on the drawings. This shall include the fabric covering and edge trim sufficient to produce a completed installation according to manufacturer's instructions and supervision acceptable to Architect and Owner.

1.04 SCOPE OF WORK

A. All walls indicated to receive tackable wall panels shall be provided with panels that have bottom and end metal continuous J trim at wall perimeter and butt joined panels edges at wall field joints. All cut edges of tackable acoustical panels at windows, doors, casework, etc. shall have continuous J trim.

1.05 QUALITY ASSURANCE

A. Maintenance Materials: Deliver usable scraps of facing to Owner's designated storage space, properly packaged and identified. Usable scraps are defined to include pieces of more than a 3 sq. ft. area and more than 8" wide. Dispose of smaller pieces.

1.06 REFERENCE

A. Tackable Wall Panels: Shall be tested in accordance with ASTM E 84/77 Steiner Tunnel Test and shall have a flame spread of 0-25.

1.07 SUBMITTALS

- A. Manufacturer's Data: Submit data to show compliance with requirements. Include test laboratory reports and manufacturer's certifications and installation/maintenance instructions and recommendations.
- B. Samples: Submit 12" x 12" samples of each facing material required.
- C. Shop Drawing: Provide drawings and manufacturer's information indicating type of tackable wall panels proposed. Include complete interior elevations of each wall which shows coordination of modular tackable system and other wall mounted items (millwork, electrical switches, etc.) tackable acoutstical wall panels shall be scribed to fit around other wall mounted or fastened items.

1.08 PRODUCT DELIVERY AND STORAGE

A. Deliver vinyl materials in protective wrapping and store inside, protected from weather, moisture and soiling.

1.09 WARRANTY

A. Provide special warranty, signed by Contractor, Installer, and Manufacturer agreeing to repair or replace defective materials and workmanship of wall systems work during two (2) year warranty period following acceptance. Provide Owner with copies of product warranties. Delete paragraph and subparagraphs below if no plastic insulation.

PART 2 - PRODUCTS

2.01 MANUFACTURERS

A. Basis-of-Design Product: Subject to compliance with requirements, provide Chatfield-Clarke "vinyl tackboard panels" or comparable product approved by Architect prior to bidding.

2.02 TACKABLE WALL SYSTEMS

A. Panels: Provide 4'-0" wide x height shown on plans. At locations with adjacent ceiling provide clearance of 1/8" between panel and ceiling. Composed of 1/2" wood fiber board 16 pcf density. Materials shall be guaranteed for one (1) year against any defect of material or workmanship.

2.03 FACING MATERIALS

A. Each type of fabric shall be from a single run or lot.

PART 3 - EXECUTION

3.01 PRE-INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS

- A. Installer must examine substrate for defects and other conditions under which wall system is to be installed and notify Contractor in writing of conditions detrimental to proper and timely completion of the work. Do not proceed until unsatisfactorily conditions have been corrected. Irregularities of the wall surface shall not be greater than 3/16".
- B. Clear away debris and scrape up deposits from surfaces to receive system; vacuum clean immediately before installation.
- C. Sequence wall system with other work as to minimize the possibility of damage and soiling of facing material during the remainder of the construction period.

3.02 INSTALLATION

- A. Install tackable acoustical wall panels in strict accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- B. Fabric:
 - 1. Install fabric plumb, level, and in proper relation to panel edges.

2. Direction of fabric shall be consistent on panel and on adjacent panels. Install fabric with consideration for pattern matching and repeats.

3.03 CLEANING AND PROTECTION

- A. Remove debris, sorting pieces to be saved from scraps to be disposed of.
- B. Advise Contractor of protection methods and materials needed to ensure that tackable wall system will be without deterioration or damage at time of acceptance.
