A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE DIRECTOR OF LINCOLN COUNTY DISASTER SERVICES AS THE LOCAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE AUTHORITY FOR THE HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE INCIDENT OCCURING WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DIETRICH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 39-7105 (1) (a) mandates that "the governing body of every city shall designate by ordinance or resolution a local emergency response authority for hazardous substance incidents within it's corporate limits"; and

WHEREAS, The Director of the Lincoln County Disaster Services is the most appropriate agency to be designated as a hazardous material response authority, having trained personnel and appropriate equipment; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DIETRICH, IDAHO THAT:

SECTION 1: That the Director for the Lincoln County Disaster Service is hereby designated by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Dietrich to be the emergency response authority for hazardous substance incidents that occur within the corporate limits of the City of Dietrich.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon it adoption and approval.
