

## SAMPLE KINDERGARTEN HOME-STUDY PLANS

### Bible:

- Bible Verse: Luke 2:10 – “And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people.” See entire passage in handouts.
- Character Trait: Attentiveness – paying close attention to what God and others say to me.
- Complete workbook p. 33 (Details in handouts.)

### Math:

- Complete calendar activities. Find Thanksgiving Day, Nov. 25 and color it brown. How many days are in a week?
- Count by 1's to 40 and by 10's to 70
- Call out the following numbers and write on lined paper: 23, 36, 17, 39, 41
- Go to education.com and click on the assignment, “Number Demolition.”

### ELA:

- Review new phonograms “m” and “n”. Practice phonograms by playing Phonogram Bingo p. 142 TM. (Lesson 27) and student workbook p. 89.
- Do the Blind Writing activity on p. 137 TM (Lesson 26).
- Do the Lesson 28 Spelling Analysis at this link: [Spelling Analysis \(logicofenglish.com\)](http://www.logicofenglish.com) Have students write on lined paper. Give help as needed.
- Finish Reader 2. Read word and glue picture to match. Read through reader giving help as needed. Encourage independence.
- Complete literature bags

### Social Studies:

- Watch this video about the Plains Indians.

- Do the tipi project. Cut out the tipi shape. Use the Indian symbols guide to draw images on the outside of the tipi. Roll the shape into a cone and tape edges to create a tipi. (See tipi picture example)

### Science:

- Complete two interesting facts about your animal on the Fabulous Facts page. Have your child do their best handwriting.
- Complete your mask.
- Make a creative picture of your animal. You can draw on a piece of paper, use construction paper to make a model, use clay to make a model, print pictures and make a collage, or paint. Be creative and use your imagination.
