## Slowing Down to Read the Signs

As you know, I do a lot of driving these days. Back and forth from Oak Creek to Pewaukee is 70 miles round trip, but I enjoy it most days. I read audiobooks and I look around at whatever catches my eye. Some cars have bumper stickers or vanity plates, but rarely do I have time to read them. Billboards are often digital and change before I can get the whole message. Plugging along at highway speed (or maybe a little beyond), there are plenty of things I miss and that's okay as long as I pay attention to the traffic most of all. If there is something I want to see, I would have
 to slow down (or get off the freeway and look from a nearby parking lot), but I'm usually not willing to do that because I want to get to my destination.

The season of LENT invites us to slow down and look around, look up, and look within. It is tempting and perhaps easier to keep our feet on the accelerator and focus on other things: getting to spring planting, packing for spring break, making plans for the end of school and summer vacation. But what might we be able to see if we slow down? If we pull off the freeway and park for a bit? If we give ourselves a chance to breathe in and take in the sights and the signs of the season?

With Ash Wednesday we have entered a time to slow and to return our eyes to God. The One who created us and set the stars in their places has so much to tell us and so much to show us. The One who comes among us in Jesus has so much love and grace to share with us. The One who brings order from chaos and new life out of death wants to do a new things in us and through us. But if I try to plow through this time at highway speed, l'll miss most of it so I'm going to work on slowing down and, if you're going fast too, I invite you to slow down with me.

I hope to see you in weekend worship and I hope you can pause during the week on Wednesdays at 5:45 for a light meal and then at 6:30 for worship. On these Wednesdays in March we will pause to read some signs and to wonder how God is speaking to each of us. In a world where we can be swept along in traffic, Lent gives us the space and time to slow down and see all that God has for us.

## MET TEAM UPDATE



Greetings Galileans! We are the Mission Exploration Team (METeam or MET). Over the next several months, we will be actively joining with you to assess Galilee's Ministry in preparation for a Call to Ministry for our new Pastor. We are targeting six months for this part of the Call process. The team is off to a fast start with key responsibilities assigned, a METeam framework of phases, goals and timelines, meeting scheduled and three "Quick Start" projects already kicked off and in planning. Stay tuned!

Because of Galilee's proximity to the lake and as home to many sailors over the years, we have adopted a sailing theme for our phases. Here is what we all can expect to happen:

PHASE 1: SCAN THE HORIZON / TEST THE WIND: Explore and discover ALL of what Galilee uniquely was, is and could be in the service of Christ in our communities. February - April.

PHASE 2: SET A COURSE: Reflect and readjust Galilee's mission and future direction to serve God's calling using our gifts and energy. April - May.

PHASE 3: ADJUST THE TILLER \& SET SAIL: Complete work to inform/advise the synod, Leadership Board and the Call Team on next steps to help us navigate the path Christ has set before us. June - July.

The Ministry Site Profile (MSP) is the final document the METeam creates; it will be approved by the Leadership Board and then used by the Call Committee, the Synod, and perspective pastors. Part of the MET process is to revisit our mission, ministries, goals and to honestly evaluate internal and external opportunities, strengths, shortcomings and threats. The METeam will do our best to lead the effort and to capture your collective voices, blessings, ideas, opinions, histories, stories and intentions. We welcome subcommittee volunteers and ask for help to connect us with people in our surrounding communities. As a congregation, we need to work together to determine what to keep, change or get rid of as we prayerfully contemplate how Christ is Calling us and what we need for pastoral leadership going forward.

Pewaukee Interchurch Lay Council/Pewaukee Food Pantry is located in the lower level of Gethsemane United Methodist Church. About 200 families a month are served by the food pantry. Because of the current economic conditions, the number of families needing assistance is growing. Each week we distribute 250-300 cans of soup and vegetables, 50-75 cans of fruit, 50 boxes of cereal, 100 cans of tuna, 50 boxes of pasta, etc. We find that during all times of the year we find it difficult to keep food on our shelves.
