IT STARTS WITH GRATITUDE

One of the first things we teach our kids is how to say thank you. Maybe it's just a popsicle at first or the sharing of a toy, but for the rest of our lives there will be things around us that call forth the opportunity for expressing gratitude. So it is good that we start young and show our kids how to respond so that it becomes a way of life, a frame of mind, and a posture of the heart.

In the coming weekends of October we will be talking about stewardship. Often the most feared or disliked word, we equate stewardship only with money and how much we are going to give to the church. We reduce it to something that feels transactional rather than spiritual, and that's a shame. Flight attendants used to be called stewards or stewardesses because they are entrusted to care for the passengers on a flight, to make sure they are safe and that they have what they need along the way. The passengers don't belong to them, but they are responsible for them for a period of time.

God made people to be stewards of this world and of one another. We are given resources and relationships to tend for a period of time. The resources and relationships don't belong to us; they come as gifts which are to bless us and which are to be turned into blessings for others. This is how we honor the Giver and the gift. This is how we say thank you for all that we have first received.

As we consider our stewardship this month, I invite us to remember that it all starts with gratitude to our Amazing God who meets us with abundant love and grace. And whatever decisions stand before us each day, may we ask ourselves, "how can my decision reflect my gratitude to God and my calling to bless as I have been blessed?"

METeam October News

After many months of surveys and meetings, the METeam has completed the Ministry Site Profile (MSP) and delivered it to the Leadership Board for its approval. So, what is next in Galilee's search for a new pastor?



The Leadership Board and the METeam will jointly host an all-congregation Town Hall meeting on Sunday, October 15. The MSP will be formally presented to the congregation for discussion and comment before it is ultimately submitted for use in the call process.

The Town Hall meeting is the final step for the METeam in our process to call a new pastor. The Leadership Board will be appointing a Call Committee who will be responsible for interviewing pastoral candidates and recommending a pastor for call.

Bishop Paul Erickson will be with us at our morning worship service and at this Town Hall meeting following the service. He will explain how the MSP will be used by our Greater Milwaukee ELCA Synod and how they will assist our Call Committee in its search and call process. We encourage you to attend this very important meeting.

The METeam sincerely thanks each one of you for your wonderful help, participation, and prayers as we have worked to understand who Galilee is and where we see our future on this journey of Christian faith. There is still a lot of work ahead and we hope you will continue to support the Call Committee and Leadership Board, as you have so generously supported us. Thank you!

October Update from Leadership Board

MSP, MSP, MSP...

September has been the month to complete the Ministry Site Profile (MSP). The METeam has done an incredible job of guiding and leading the Congregation through a variety of interviews, meetings, surveys and other information gathering tasks that were used to compile information about who Galilee has been, who we are today and where we want to go in the future. They have completed their final draft of the MSP and have asked all of you to assist in providing a final review as well. The MSP is now in the hands of the Leadership Board and we are finalizing a few items that we were tasked to complete. We will soon be handing this off to the Synod for their review and they will begin the process of working with Galilee and presenting candidates to our Call Committee for consideration. The Leadership Board wishes to thank the METeam for all of their efforts and to also thank the Congregation for your continued help in this process.

As the Leadership Board works to complete the areas of the MSP that we are tasked with we too have been having additional meetings both with the Board as well as the Congregation to discern where Galilee sits on a few critical issues. These conversations have been very useful in learning about where Galilee is in terms of our desire to be a move diverse and inclusive Congregation and how that may drive us going forward. The Leadership Board will be prayerfully considering all that we have learned and looks to make final decisions in these areas before finalizing the MSP and sending it on the Synod. I would ask that all pray on this and consider where God is leading Galilee at this point and time.

CALL COMMITTEE

With the MSP wrapping up it means we are now ready for the Call Committee! This should be a very exciting time for us all as we now move to the part of the process where we will interview candidates and choose a new Pastor. The Leadership Board has started the process of pulling the Call Committee together and will be looking to finalize this group by early October at the latest. Many thanks to those who have shown an interest in serving. We are all anxious to see this Committee begin their work!

TOWN HALL MEETING

What is this? The Town Hall meeting is scheduled for October 15th at 10:15 AM following the morning service. We will be joined on this day by the Bishop who will talk to the Congregation about the type of candidate we are seeking and how the Call process will work. Please consider making time in your schedule to attend this meeting and participate in the conversation. This will be an important event in this process and will give you an opportunity to hear directly from the Synod on what to expect.

To close for this month, this past year has been an interesting time for reflection for our Congregation. Some clear themes have been put out in terms of where we have been, who we are today and where we want to go. As with many organizations there is not a 100%/"all in" path on some topics but there usually is a general consistency in our thoughts as a group. With a better-defined direction and ultimately a new Pastor I think it's safe to say that we can anticipate that there will be some changes at Galilee. Those changes will be based on the results of the process we all have spent the better part of the last 10 months on. I hope that you will look forward with great anticipation as we discover where we are going while we continue our walk with Jesus and consider the path God is guiding us to.






