

# FROM METEAM TO CALL COMMITTEE - HERE WE GO!

After eight months of work led by our METeam, Galilee's transition process now moves into the hands of our Call Committee. Let me offer my gratitude to our METeam who met countless times to pray and discuss and learn and discern together. They led congregational surveys and conversations; they stepped out into the surrounding community to interview area leaders; they processed a massive amount of data, insights, and questions that led to the completion of our Ministry Site Profile. I truly enjoyed serving with them as they brought their faith and their curiosity to our work.

As Bishop Erickson explained at our Town Hall Meeting on October 15th, the Call Committee will now begin its work. Appointed by the Leadership Board, the Call Committee of Heather Evans, Doug Dehler, Deb Kohler, Steve Hanson, Anne Riegert, Max Smith, and Sarah Spencer will soon meet with Pr. Kristin Nielsen from the Synod office for an orientation. The first task of the Call Committee then is to study our Ministry Site Profile and develop the interview process and questions it wants to use with pastoral candidates. I encourage you to pray for the Call Committee members during November, asking God to bond them together as a team and to guide them in their preparation for interviews.

My role as Interim Pastor shifts now at Galilee. Though I was highly involved with the METeam, I am not involved with the Call Committee. I can still answer basic process questions and Pr. Kristin will work directly with the Call Committee and with the Leadership Board once the Call Committee has a pastoral candidate to recommend for call. My ministry continues as your pastor, leading worship, supporting leaders, offering pastoral care, and teaching. It is a joy to serve with you all in this time of transition.



# **FAITH FORMATION**



Do you believe in the power of prayer? Have you experienced that power in your own life? Do you find joy in praying for others? Would you like to increase/expand your prayer life?

If your answer to any of the questions is "yes" we'd like to invite you to join our PoP (Power of Prayer) Squad. Galilee's Sunday School team is leading the way with this effort to bring the generations together in a powerful way. Here's how it will work:

- Indicate your willingness to participate by filling out a simple PoP Squad participant form. You will be asked for your name, birthday month & date, your grade or occupation, things you like to do, and up to three suggestions of how someone can pray for you.
- Shhh! It's a secret! PoP Squad team members will be given the name of someone to pray for and that person's information. The person you are praying for will not be the same person who is praying for you.
- Pairings will be chosen at random, or as I like to think, inspired by the Holy Spirit. Please keep the name of the person you are praying for a secret. Names will be revealed at the end of the faith formation year in May.
- ALL ages are invited to participate and Sunday School kids will be involved. Adults may be praying for a child, and vice versa.

We hope to launch the PoP Squad at the beginning of 2024. In order to allow for time to collect information, determine pairings, and getting information out to all PoP Squad members, we need to begin in November. Watch the e-news and look for PoP Squad participant cards in the narthex.

# GO-GETTERS






