- Q: What can membership do to help BOD advocate for more pickleball courts?
- A: Tim responded that the BOD has tried more than once, and Corby Foster WR General Manager states, that for the time being, the answer is "no". Corporate at Troon are the final decision makers.
- Q: When will lower courts be resurfaced?
- A: Courts are to be resurfaced every 5 years, so should be coming up for resurfacing in the future.
