Who is interested to join the Lake Ecosystem Advisory Committee

The Lake Ecosystem Advisory Committee of the Township of Frontenac is a Committee of Council that was formed in 2020 to support the health and welfare of the Township's lake ecosystems and the enjoyment and use of lakes by residents, visitors and future generations. The Committee is in need of new members.

The committee's mandate includes hosting an annual Lake Associations Forum where Lake Associations and residents can network with one another, share best practices, voice common concerns, and discuss emerging trends. It also provides feedback on Township policy, strategic plans and budgets, and coordinates and collects feedback from lake associations throughout the year.

In 2021, the Township introduced Lake Ecosystem Grants. This committee reviews all grant applications and recommends which projects should receive funding under the program. The committee partners with different agencies to conduct research, data analysis and public education and outreach activities on lake ecosystems.

South Frontenac is looking for six representatives from lake associations and two members of the public at large to serve on the Lake Ecosystem Advisory Committee. The Committee meets four times a year on the fourth Thursday of the following months: March, June, September and December at 6:00 pm. The Committee will serve for the term of Council.
