Trip Overview

Two groups of 10 brothers and 10 sisters will complete a backpacking trip along Michigan's northern coast. Each group will be led by two adults: an Islamic scholar and an experienced outdoorsman/woman. Participants must arrive to Dearborn by noon on Tuesday, July 30th for staging and remain in Dearborn after the trip until noon on Sunday, August 4th for wrap-up.



Trip Details

Brothers and sisters ages 17-20 are eligible to register. Food, gear, and transportation to and from Dearborn will be included. Each day will require 3-8 miles of hiking while carrying 30-40 pounds. The brothers and sisters will be hiking the same route in opposite directions. The cost for each person is \$500.



What to Expect

Spending time in nature is rejuvenating, and backpacking provides an opportunity to intimately enjoy its beauty. Unforeseen challenges always arise in The Great Outdoors, but working through them together will build a special and lasting bond.
