


1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 213 responses




2.How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? 212 responses








### 5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.




### 6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?




## 7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.




# 8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth








### 10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes






### 12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.








15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.




16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.








19. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.





Summary of the Report on Teaching-Learning Experience at Kashi Sahu College Seraikella

This report summarizes the feedback received from students at Kashi Sahu College Seraikella regarding their teaching-learning experience. Here's a breakdown of the observations and suggestions for improvement:

#### **Observations:**

- **Infrastructure:** Lack of proper facilities like restrooms, canteen, and a designated space for parking bicycles and motorcycles.
- **Transportation:** No bus service for students, creating difficulties commuting to the college.
- Faculty: Inadequacy in the number of teachers in some departments.
- **Learning Resources:** Limited access to books and practical equipment in some programs.

- Encourage teachers to incorporate technology and interactive methods in their teaching styles.
- Foster better communication channels between teachers and students.
- Enforce stricter disciplinary measures to ensure regular class attendance.
- Address the subject-specific teacher shortage

Overall, the feedback highlights a need for improvement in infrastructure, transportation, faculty availability, communication, and teaching methods. By addressing these concerns, Kashi Sahu College Seraikella can create a more conducive and enriching learning environment for its students.
