



Music for the Royal Fireworks Overture - G. F. Handel, arr. by Thor Johnson


Handel composed his Music for the Royal Fireworks while working for King George II in 1749. The piece was composed to accompany the royal celebration of the ending of the War of the Austrian succession. Over 12,000 people bought tickets to a public rehearsal, and the traffic caused an hours-long closure of London Bridge.

Don Giovanni Overture K 527

- W.A. Mozart

Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart (1756-1791) composed his 2 act opera *Don Giovanni* in 1787. It was an immediate success with audiences and remains one of the most popular operas of all time. Mozart famously composed the overture on October 28th, the night before the opera's premiere. Legend has it that the musicians sight-read the overture so well that the audience that night at the Estates Theatre in Prague applauded the work enthusiastically.

Ancient Airs and Dances

- O. Respighi

Suite No. 1 P 109 was composed in 1917. It was based on Renaissance lute pieces by Simone Molinaro, Vincenzo Galile<u>i</u> (father of Galileo Galilei) and additional anonymous composers. The pieces are: Balletto: "Il Conte Orlando" (Simone Molinaro, 1599), Gagliarda (Vincenzo Galilei, 1550s), Villanella (anonymous, end of 16th century)

Overture from Egmont op. 84

- Ludwig van Beethoven

In the music for *Egmont*, Beethoven expresses his own political concerns through the exaltation of the heroic sacrifice of a man condemned to death for having taken a valiant stand against oppression. The Overture became an unofficial anthem of the 1956 Hungarian revolution.

Downton Abbey – The Suite - By John Lunn, arr by Douglas E. Wagner

The Suite features the best musical segments from the extremely well-received PBS period drama, *Downton Abbey*. The music is moving and richly textured and the emotion-packed score comes to life in full orchestral color.

Selections from Phantom of the Opera - Sir Andrew Lloyd Weber, arr. by Calvin Custer

Sit back and enjoy Sir Andrew Lloyd Webber's timeless music, arranged by Calvin Custer in a medley featuring six musical highlights from both the film and stage versions: *All I Ask of You, Angel of Music, Masquerade, The Music of the Night, The Phantom of the Opera,* and *Think of Me.*
