The piece came from a collection, purchased by Mr Young, which had a number of "detached" identities, all of which have since proved correct. There is, therefore, little doubt about the integrity of this identification.

Established about 1908. Sold to Cooper McDougall & Robertson in 1927. Merged into Imperial Chemical Industries in 1937. Later became "Plant Protection Limited" (a subsidiary of I.C.I.) in 1954 with a factory at Yalding in Kent.

"Abol" is the trade name of an insecticide.
