Then JOHN LUFT, who has to put all the bits and pieces in the envelopes, stick on the addressed labels, stick on the correct amount of postage for land, sea and air, and then get them posted; about 250 in total. On your behalf, I acknowledge the debt we owe to these two members for their share in the work of the society.

CATALOGUES by Michael Rucklidge.

Obviously we try to make the catalogues we publish as complete and as accurate as we can. Equally obviously we fall short of this. We feel that it is better to publish even if the information may be incomplete or wrong. If we do not publish we shall not receive corrections and additions which would improve our catalogues.

In addition to the complete letter sections of the Tomkins catalogue we propose to issue, as available:-

- a) addition pages to letter sections already issued.
- b) correction pages containing corrections, additions etc. to letter sections already issued.

These will in general be printed together - four A5 pages on a double sided A4 sheet so that they can be separated. One of these should be included this month. Thus addition pages can be inserted in the appropriate place, and the correction pages discarded after the appropriate corrections have been made.

Errors arise from several sources - wrong information given to us - typing mistakes - wrong judgements etc. If you spot mistakes or omissions please let the secretary have the appropriate corrections. They will be incorporated in the relevant catalogue as soon as convenient. In this way you can all help to improve our publications.

It is hoped to issue a complete letter portion of the Tomkins catalogue with each Bulletin. The 'period of use' letters for each perfin are derived from only two collections, so there must be many additions to these.

PERFIN IDENTIFICATION

Identifying perfins can often be a simple task, especially if an identities catalogue is to hand. Then it is just a matter of checking that the perfin matches the catalogue description. Or, you may have a perfined stamp on a cover with an identity printed on the front or embossed on the

flap. Trade Cards, too, are an easy form of identification.

Single, loose perfins, however, can make identification a task worthy of the deductive talents of Sherlock Holmes. Take as an example a recently acquired perfin of mine. The perfin is MAY/&/Co. 15,10,7/13/8,6 5½mm. This is not the most common of names. Yet enquiries of collectors more knowledgeable than myself have brought no results, nor have searches through Bulletins of the last 6 years or New Identities helped at all.

Some information comes from the stamp itself. Fortunately there is a clear and almost complete double circle postmark of Aldershot, dated 17 Sept '08, on an Edwardian 1d red. The perfin is in 3 lines and that is the sum total of information to be gleaned. The king looks stern but can volunteer nothing! !

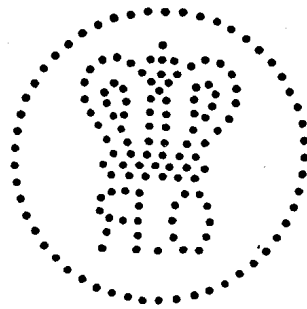
Then, from the darkness of uncertainty, a gleam of hope in the shape of 3 German covers. 2 are registered envelopes from German banks, one in Cologne, one in Plauen. The other is an envelope from a firm with branches in 5 major cities. All were posted in 1922 and addressed to the same firm in England, namely SIMON, MAY & Co. Two were addressed only to Nottingham but the third, more specifically, to Week-day Cross, Nottingham.

Now here lies the problem of identification. Tantalising fragments of fact which pose more questions. Is the perfin MAY/&/Co. that of the firm Simon, May & Co of Nottingham or is it merely wishful thinking? If so, what is the connection between the Aldershot postmark on the perfined stamp and the Nottingham address on the German covers? Is there any connection between this perfin and the firm of Bryant and May the match makers? Perhaps some Bulletin readers may be able to supply additional information which would help to positively identify this puzzling perfin.

A NEW OFFICIAL PERFIN

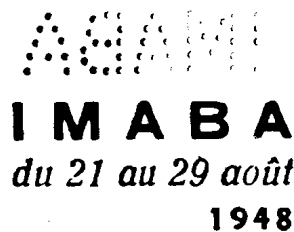
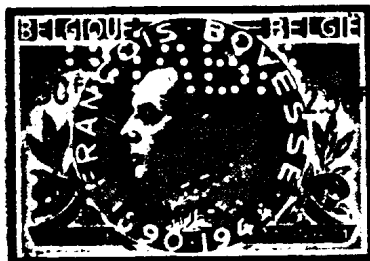

Upon acquiring the stamp illustrated here, Mr. Brandt checked in the Officials' Catalogue, and found that it is, as yet, an unpublished die. As can be seen, it is a CROWN/O.R in circle, on a 5/- Victoria Judicature Fees issue - on piece. There is no cancel to help with user.

The 2 stamps illustrated below are from a set of 9 which were perforated through the face side, I M A B A, and also underprinted, 'IMABA du 21 au 29 août 1948'. The set is also overprinted on the face, 'LUCHTPOST POST AERIENNE'. The set is unlisted in Gibbons.



Perhaps some member knows more about this particular exhibition and the meaning of the letters.

MEMBERS COMMENTS ON ARTICLES IN PREVIOUS BULLETINS

Wm Dawson article in Bulletin 238

HARRY DOBSON writes to say that during the war, his wife worked for a firm evacuated to Beaconsfield in Buckinghamshire and remembers another firm with the name of DAWSON, taking premises there for offices. They were publishers and he wonders if any of the GVI WD/&S perfins bear Beaconsfield postmarks. (Mine do not)

REG POWELL writes to say that he does not have a copy of W 204.1 (nor have I); he has a cover similar to mine with die W 204.3 (date 8.8.40); a loose stamp of W 204.2 and there appears to be a W 204.2A with D & S slightly raised. This die seems to be on Wilding and Machin stamps. A fifth die also enters the arena on GVI light colours and the 5/- GVI (SG 510). The overall width of this is 12mm. If I obtain photocopies of these last two variants I will put them in the next Bulletin.

Reg also asks if there is any connection with the firm of the same name who are identified as users of D 437 (D.S.) and D 439.7 (D&S). D 439.7 is found from the 1d.plate number period (mine is plate 220) and closely followed by D 437. Both occur with Newspaper Branch cancellations DS/F. (My copy of 437 is a 9d Jubilee with London Foreign Branch Oval cancel.)

D 437 was used at least to the Wembley Exhibition period, and Reg has a censored cover addressed to Copenhagen that is identified by 'Wm. Dawson & Sons, Ltd., (Low's Export Department), St. Dunstan's House, Fetter Ln., London E.C.' Date is April 2nd 1918.

MAGNUS WERNER from Sweden seems to give Reg his answer. He has sent photocopies of a cover bearing a 2½d GV stamp, perfined W 204.3, dated 1927. The address is 'Wm. Dawson & Sons, Ltd., Low's Export Department, Roll's Buildings, Fetter Ln., London E.C.4! This certainly links the D 437 (D.S.) to W 204.3 (WD/&S).

JACK BRANDT, Canada, also writes -with details of dates of use. W 204.3 from late Victoria (including Revenue and Pre-cancels) to GVI dark colours. One cover, dated 1907, from Cannon House, Breams Building, London, with postmark W.C. but another GV on piece dated 1930 with part of address as London E.C.4.

W 204.2 appears to have 3 types (this ties in with comments from Reg Powell). The die as W 204.2 in the catalogue, he has en GVI light colours and decimal Machins. The first variant is on GVI light colours. He has a cover for this to India cancelled London W.C. in 1948 and the address is Cannon House, Macklin Street, London W.C.2.

The second variant is on large EVII issues. Again, Jack too has no cover for W 204.1 but the two covers he has detailed, both have this date of '1809' printed with the address which ties them to the one firm. On the cover of 1907 the added information reads, 'Newsvendors, Booksellers and Stationers', so possibly the firm had different types of stores at the different locations.

C R PERFIN article from Bulletin 239

In his article in April, John Nelson mentioned that in 1976 - when the Bowman Railway Perfins Book was published - Die 2 of the Cambrian Railway was known, used, on only two covers.

John did not mention that later (unfortunately date not recorded by myself) we had an addendum to the Bowmen book, which said that this perfin has a stop between the letters C and R. For members who have bought the Railway Book and have not got this addendum, we can put full details in the next Bulletin if you so ask.

If there is a perfin C R 8,11 4mm without a stop, after reading the next letter from Derrik Rayner, it could help John's hypothesis.

DERRIK RAYNER writes to say that he has a C.R perfin on a ½d plate 12 8,11 height nearer 4½ than 4 judging from the illustration supplied by Mr. Rayner.

The interesting point is that the cancellation is OSWE(STRY), AU 22 80 Code A, although the '8' of 80 is not very clear. The stamp was purchased along with a collection of Caledonian Railway perfins, all with Scottish postmarks except this one. The vendor had queried its authenticity, thinking at that time it could be a fake. However, as Oswestry was the Head Office town of the Cambrian Railway, one could be forgiven for assuming this to be a Cambrian Railway perfin.

HARRY DOBSON puts forward another interesting idea about C R perfins. He has a GV ½d (SG351) with perfin C 6410.04 C R 8,11 5½mm postmarked BUTE DOCK.

He tells me that The Bute Dock Company was created in 1887 and the name changed to The Cardiff Railway Company in 1897. In 1922 it was incorporated into the G.W.R.

If this is a Cardiff Railway Company perfin, it would only have had a life of 25 years. Has any other members similar cancellations on this perfin?

IDENTIFICATION QUERIES in Bulletin 239

JOHN NELSON has supplied the answer to Reg Powells' unknown perfin on Page 7. TS/MS is The Singer Manufacturing Company, Sewing Machine Makers, 17 Chiswell St., Finsbury, E.C. Also the answer to Boris Pritt on Page 14. E.A/&W.G. is Edward Acraman & William Greenslade, Brush & plane makers, Thomas St., Bristol. I have added these at the end of the New Identities.

HILLMAN – HUMBER QUERY from Bulletin 239.

DAVID HILL writes to say that Humber did not become part of the Rootes group until 1930. He thinks that Rootes had already acquired Hillman by 1930 so the identity H 4490.02 H/L^d dated 1900 must be Humber Ltd. in its own right.

Mr. Hill goes on to suggest that a theme about Motor Company Perfins would be as interesting as the Railway Perfins, and much easier to collate. Has anyone done this already and would be willing to pass on their findings; or do we have offers to research the topic?

TAFF VALE RAILWAY article in Bulletin 239.

In his article, Reg left us in the dark as to which of the dies of TV/R is the scarce one. He tells me it is T 4820.02 - the die with the 'straight' leg.

Another member, DERRIK RAYNER, has two of these cards dated 30-5-04 and 20-11-07. The former being the blue-green card, the latter the yellow-green, both with die 4820.01.

From Tom Variables article in Bulletin 229 it would seem that dates run from 1902 to 1912, but no differentiation between the two dies. The blue-green 'stamp' card used between 8-9-02 and 13-2-05.

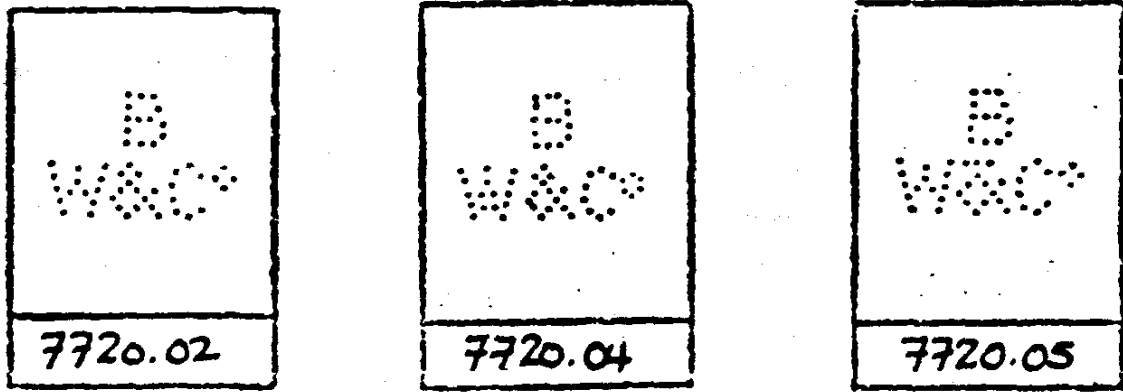
The yellow-green 'stamp' on thick white card on 19-5-06.

The yellow-green 'stamp' on thin, cream/buff card between 24-5-05 & 12-6-12.

Can anyone extend these dates?

BESSLER. WAECHTER & Co.. Ltd.

Up to date, only 3 dies have been positively identified as emanating from Bessler, Waechter & Co., Ltd. W7720.02; W77720.04; W7720.05. They all have different forms of B/W&C°.



The respective addresses for these 3 positive identifications are:-

- W 7720.02 Newcastle - on - Tyne. (1906)
- W 7720.04 58 Lombard Street, London E.C (1880)
- W 7720.05 Glasgow. (1908)

Now Reg Powell has produced two more covers, both with variants of W7720.05. Below are illustrated the two dies. I have had to trace them, as they are on cover, but I have done this as faithfully as possible.



As can be seen, Fig. A shows the B leaning backwards to the left whereas 7720.05 leans forward to the right. Fig. B shows the upstroke of the B more central over the ampersand.

The address on the 'A' cover is Glasgow (½d GV/2 stamp)

The address on the 'B' cover is Salisbury House, Finsbury Circus,
London E.C. (1911)

Reg wonders if this is an example of a firm having different Perfins for each of its branches. If anyone else has covers for this firm and could send an accurate tracing of the die plus the address and date, it may show a pattern.

Provisionals - The works of Messrs. J. Sloper and Son (who perfinned stamps for many different clients) were damaged by enemy action in 1941 and a number of dies were destroyed. Slopers continued to perfin stamps using emergency arrangements which involved perforating two or more single letters or groups of letters in separate operations. This resulted in perfins with similar lettering but differing (non-aligned) arrangement. These are not listed separately but grouped together under a single catalogue number, the number being suffixed by a "p" indicating the existence of these "provisionals".

It would be advisable to correct your Tomkins or Edwards' pages from the Addendum as soon as possible so that we will not be advised of corrections which have already been published. Whether you retain or discard the Addendum pages is your prerogative. The 'A' Addendum can not be discarded of course as the 'A' Additions are on the reverse.

Lastly, this half of the double spread needs to be cut from the Introduction Page 4 and this Page 4 substituted for the original of the new Tomkins Catalogue.
