WHO KNOWS THE ANSWER?

Dr Reg Powell sends the following items in the hope that someone can help with the identities.

- (1) King Edward VII postmarked Glasgow March 20th 1905, on piece of postcard containing part of name "Allan" and telegraphic address "ALLANS" GLASGOW.

Perfin:- Cat. J9.1 J&A/A 7,13,10/10 4½/4½

- (2) Perfin:- Cat. G135 G.D/&Co.. 10,11/14,9,8 (III)

This perfin appears to have been most prolific during the Edwardian era with postmarks from all over the British Isles, some of which are, London, Manchester, Birmingham, Stone, Sunderland, Plymouth, Penzance, Glasgow Helensburgh, Thornhill, and even Portree on the Isle of Skye and Lockmaddy in the Isle of North Uist.

SHIPPING COMPANY PERFINs

It appears that there is some doubt about the page numbering in this listing, so perhaps a few words of explanation will not come amiss.

Mike Burrows, who is responsible for turning out these excellent treatises, feels that he cannot hope to produce them in what will be the final order of assembly. He has, therefore, adopted a similar numbering system to the *Identities Catalogue* pages, i.e., initially by the initial letter of the shipping company, and then numerical order in each letter group.

When all is complete, we hope to publish an index and a page or two of the perfins illustrated.

S.E.P.S. PERFIN PERMITTED ON THE STAMPS OF EIRE

The following text is the reply to an enquiry as to whether or not the SEPS perfin would be acceptable on the stamps of Eire (A SEPS perfin on a British stamp was enclosed with the enquiry).

Dear Sir,

Subject: Perforation of Postage Stamps

Thank you for your letter dated 21 June 1977 in connection with the above.

Stamps may be perforated as in the sample you sent to us provided that the perforating holes are no larger than those dividing one stamp from another.

The work of perforating stamps with initials is not undertaken by the Post Office.

Apart from the points brought out in the letter, the Post Office regulations also note that only initials, not names or trade marks may be used.

Any member may, therefore, send current mint stamps of Eire to Brian Birch for perforation with the Society's perforator. There is no charge for this service but stamps to the value of return postage will be retained.

A circular issued in 1856 by Ralph Ward Jackson, announced the inauguration of the steam service between West Hartlepool, Hamburg and St. Petersburg, by the West Hartlepool Steam Navigation Company. Jackson, who was born in 1806, was the first Member of Parliament for West Hartlepool, and although he owned, with Robinson Jackson, a fleet of five screw steamships, the administration and control appears to have been in the hands of the West Hartlepool Harbour & Railway Company.

About 1862 the Shipping Line was disposed of, to Pyle, Spence and Company. Following the failure of Overend, Gurney & Company, the banking concern, the Line found a new owner in the shape of Christopher Maling Webster. The management was entrusted to Captain W.J. Young who, in a statement issued on 12th January 1867, announced that the Company would continue trading, adopting the title "The West Hartlepool Steam Navigation Company".

When Captain Young died in 1886, Mr T. Barraclough was appointed to the post. C. M. Webster passed away in August 1893, leaving an estate valued at £257,000. He was succeeded by his son Ernest Alfred Webster.

On March 2nd 1899 a new company was formed under the chairmanship of Sir Christopher Furness, with a share capital of £500,000. The title changing to West Hartlepool Steam Navigation Company Limited. At this time the fleet consisted of twenty vessels.

In 1902, besides the branch office at Newport, it was decided to open another at Cardiff. Sir C. Furness disposed of his shares in 1904. A subsidiary was formed in 1906, The Dinsdalehall Shipping Company. This was managed by J.E. Guthe.

At the beginning of the first world war the fleet consisted of sixteen vessels, three of which were owned by the subsidiary. In November 1914 another subsidiary appeared, the Wiltonhall Shipping Company Limited. With the loss of the 'Wiltonhall' by a torpedo in the Mediterranean on July 16th 1916 this company lost its entire fleet.

The other subsidiary was left vessel-less in 1919 when the 'Kepwickhall' was sold to Town Line of Cardiff and the 'Cliftonhall' to the Trowbridge Shipping Company Limited.
