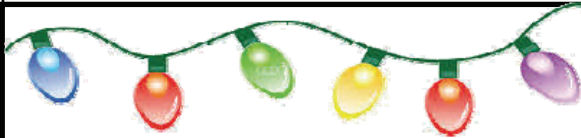
If the office is not open and you would like to make a payment please use our door slot and be sure to push your payment all the way through.
