

ORDINANCE 3-2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF TRAPPE TO INCREASE THE ANNUAL SALARY PAID TO THE COUNCIL OF TRAPPE FROM \$2,000 ANNUALLY TO \$3,000 ANNUALLY, TO BECOME EFFECTIVE FOR COUNCIL MEMBERS ELECTED AFTER THE MAY 2023 ELECTION, AND TO INCREASE THE SALARY PAID TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERS FROM \$1,000 ANNUALLY TO \$1,500 ANNUALLY TO BECOME EFFECTIVE FOR MEMBERS APPOINTED ON OR AFTER MAY 2024

WHEREAS, the Charter of the Town of Trappe Section 204 authorizes the Council of Trappe to receive an annual salary;

WHEREAS, the Charter of the Town of Trappe authorizes the Council to establish said salary, and from time to time, by ordinance, provided that the salary shall not be changed during the period for which that Council member was elected;

WHEREAS, the Council has determined it is in the best interest of the Town to increase the salary paid to the Council to \$3000 annually, to become effective for the next succeeding Council member after the May 2023 election;

WHEREAS, the Council has further determined it is in the best interest of the Town to increase the salary paid to Planning Commission members from \$1,000 annually to \$1,500 annually to become effective for members appointed after May 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of Trappe hereby ordain as follows:

1. The annual salary paid to the Council will be \$3000;
2. This increase will not be paid to any Council member during their current term;
3. The increase will be paid to the next succeeding Council member after the May 2023 election and those elected or appointed thereafter.
4. The annual salary paid to the Planning Commission will be \$1,500;
5. The increase will not be paid to any Planning Commission member during their current term;
6. The increase will be paid to the next succeeding Planning Commission member appointed May 2024 and those appointed thereafter.

ENACTED this 5th day of July, 2023.

This Ordinance shall become effective on the 20th day of July, 2023.
