

RESOLUTION NO. 3-2023

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF TRAPPE TO AMEND THE CHARTER FOR THE TOWN OF TRAPPE BY REPEALING THE TERM LIMIT PROVISION SET FORTH IN SECTION 201

WHEREAS, Md. Code Ann. Local Gov't Article, § 4-304 confers upon the Council of Trappe the authority to initiate proposed amendments the Charter for the Town of Trappe; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Trappe, under the grant of general authority and express powers, may regulate its own election; and

WHEREAS, the Council of Trappe has determined that it is desirable and in the public interest to amend Section 201 of the Charter for the Town of Trappe to repeal the term limit provision of said section.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF TRAPPE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 201 of the Charter for the Town of Trappe is hereby amended as follows:


Section 201. Number, Selection and Term of Commissioners

All legislative and executive powers of the town shall be vested in a body designated as "The Council of Trappe" consisting of five Commissioners who shall be elected as hereinafter provided and who shall hold office for a term of four years or until the succeeding Council take office. The regular term of the Commissioners shall expire on the second Monday following the election of their successors. ~~The terms of the Commissioners shall be limited to two (2) consecutive elected terms. (Res. No. 4-7-3).~~


Section 2.: This Resolution shall be posted and published in accordance with the requirements set forth in Md. Code Ann. Local Government Article, § 4-304.

Section 3: This Resolution shall become effective 50 days after final enactment unless a petition for referendum has been filed prior thereto in accordance with Section 4-304 of the Local Government Article of the Maryland Annotated Code. This Resolution shall be deemed "finally enacted" on the date on which the Council of Trappe indicates its approval of this Resolution by affixing their signatures hereto.




