Meeting Minutes - Match 22, 2022
Hybrid Go-To-Meeting at Denny's in Cameron Park

The meeting was called to order by President **Doug Drake** at 7:00, Compatriot **Sam Bradley** gave the invocation, Compatriot **Sam Bradley** led the Pledge of Allegiance and President **Doug Drake** led the SAR Pledge.

The "Zoom-type" meeting capability was facilitated by Compatriot **Russ Kaiser** through his 'Go-To-Meeting' account. (*Thank you, Russ*)

There were seven (7) regular Chapter members, Russ Kaiser, Tom Adams, Doug Drake (Z), Bob Conover, Tom Douglas (Z), Sam Bradley and Kevin Tierney. We had one guest, Clinton Bazzill, who has expressed an interest in joining SAR. Tom Douglas and Doug Drake have offered to help him, and they discussed his application progress and requested some additional documentation.

The meeting was opened as a regular meeting and the officers were called upon to give their report.

- Treasurer, **Bob Conover**, reported on the Chapter's financial status:
 - He reported our checking account balance at \$2,900.
 - He also pointed out to anyone who held a Chapter bank card that they had expired.

- o Further, **Treasure Conover** provided a correction to last month's Treasurer Report as reported in the March *Dispatch*: We have paid to the American Legion two checks; the checks are \$100 for American Legion Hall Rental Deposit, and \$125 for the 'Bar' License; for a total deposit of **\$225** held by American Legion Post 119 for our next event.
- Secretary, **Tom Douglas**, gave his report:
 - O Secretary Douglas requested approval of changes to two Chapter Bylaws, one regarding state/in-state dual membership and one regarding the definition of associates. These changes were emailed to the membership in accordance with Chapter bylaws and brought up at previous Chapter meetings. After a brief discussions and explanation that the changes were necessary to be in agreement with State and National bylaws the changes were approved with no dissenting votes.
- Youth Programs Coordinator, Kevin Tierney, gave his report:
- Kevin reported regarding the brochure contest, we had a total of 26 entries. 22 of those came from John Adams Academy, 2 from Rolling Hills Middle School and one entry was mailed directly to Kevin from a homeschooled young person.
- Kevin reported a Chapter Brochure Contest winner has been entered into the State Contest.
- Kevin reported the Mother Lode Chapter received Posters from one school,
 John Adams Academy.
- Kevin reported a Chapter Poster Contest winner has been entered into the State Contest.
- Dispatch Editor, **Tom Adams**, reported the **March Dispatch** went out as an email instead of a PDF attachment. Tom intends to continue using emails.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

• President Doug Drake had previously appointed Kevin Tierney to be 2nd Vice-President-Programs. The be 2nd Vice-President-Programs is a Chapter elected position. At the Match Chapter meeting, Compatriot Tom Adams nominated Keven Tierney to be the Mother Lode Chapter 2nd Vice-President-Programs. The Nomination was seconded by Compatriot Sam Bradley. Keven Tierney was then unanimously elected to be the Mother Lode Chapter 2nd Vice-President-Programs. A description of duties follows:

The 2nd Vice-President-Meetings shall oversee all of the various chapter programs. They include, but are not limited to, the: ROTC/JROTC Program, Eagle Scout Program, Knight Essay Contest, Law Enforcement Program, Flag Certificate Program, and Valley Forge Program. COMMENTS by GUEST

Our one guest, **Clinton Bazzill**, said he was working on his SAR application, and looking forward to joining us as a member.

OLD BUSINESS

- Compatriot **Bob Conover**, serving as Chapter's **Public Safety Liaison**, asked if the Chapter was planning to hold a Community Awards event in 2022, for he had been approached by the County Sheriff.
- Compatriot Sam Bradley shared that the American Legion Post 119 had held a Law Enforcement Recognition Event on **March 2**nd, the event was well attended, and masks were not required.
- President **Doug Drake** set a target date for our event to be our planned regular Chapter October meeting, **Tuesday October 25**, **2022**. He asked **Bob Conover**, Chapter's **Public Safety Liaison** to query in the law enforcement community to see if there would be interest in our Chapter holding our Community Awards Banquet. He said we would discuss the option at our **April Meeting**.

NEW BUISINESS

- Compatriot **Tom Adams** raised the past practice of our awarding our **Mother Lode Chapter pins** to every young person who participated in our contests by either entering Poster as 5th grader or entering a Brochure as an 8th grader. Tom Douglas gave an accounting of the number of **Mother Lode Chapter pins** compared the number of participants reported by **Kevin Tierney**, and we learned we <u>did not have</u> enough pins in our inventory to make the awards this year. Douglas estimated the pins cost \$1.50 each at the time of purchase 4-5 years ago.
- Compatriot **Tom Adams** then described the last awarding of pins which was in **2020** at **John Adams Academy** and how impressive it was. Apparently, at the direction of JAA teachers, the scholars (as they are called) formed a single line and processed up to Mother Lode Chapter uniformed color guards, shook the member hand and received their pin. In Adams' experience this had never occurred before. We usually just pass out the pins, like candy. Compatriots **Sam Bradley** and **Russ Kaiser** who were Color Guards at the event echoed Adams, praise and desire to make this a regular part of our awards presentations.
- Compatriot **Tom Adams** then made a motion to authorize Compatriot **Tom Douglas** to purchase the quantity of **Mother Lodes Chapter pins** using Chapter funds, not to exceed, **\$500**, and that the Chapter would solicit donations from Chapter members, and others, to cover the Chapter expenditures of Youth Program Awards to include the Chapter pins. Compatriot Sam Bradley seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

CLOSE OF MEETING

Compatriot **Sam Bradley** gave the Benediction, **President Doug Drake** led the SAR Recessional, the members all sang **God Bless America**, and the meeting was adjourned at 7:50.


