Mother Lode Chapter Meeting Minutes, January 28, 2020 Denny's Restaurant, Cameron Park, CA

The meeting was called to order by President Mike Muetz at 6:30 PM. The Invocation was given by 1^{st} Vice President Sam Bradley, the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Compatriot Kevin Tierney, and the SAR Pledge was led by Compatriot Tom Adams.

There were eight members, **Tom Adams, Steve Almy, Sam Bradley, Bob Conover, Tom Douglas, Mike** Mu**etz, Kevin Tierney**, Duel Member **Don Littlefield** and two guests, **Randall Keith** and guest speaker **Rob Flowers** in attendance. It was noted regular attendees Duel Member Tom Chilton and Marilyn Chilton were spending time with visiting family and Member John Krahn was still home with Joy, recovering from an accident.

President Muetz welcomed the guests and the minutes of the November 26, 2019 were approved.

Reports: Secretary Douglas passed out a copy of an updated list of the Chapter inventory. There were no immediate needs or items to be ordered. Medals and certificates for upcoming events could be ordered prior to the event. The Chapter "2019 Year End Report" for entry in "The Book" at the 2020 CASSAR Spring Meeting was sent by email to the CASSAR Secretary.

Treasurer Bob Conover reported a year end bank balance of \$5007.56. There is an outstanding check of \$1,045.00 to the CASSAR for National and State dues paid by Mother Lode Chapter Members.

Youth Activities Coordinator Kevin Tierney reported although they had the state winner in the eighth grade Brochure Contest last year the John Adams Academy has not yet responded to Compatriot Tierney to enter this year's Brochure Contest. Camerado Springs Middle School with teacher Rob Flowers will again enter the Brochure Contest. John Adams Academy will enter this year's fifth grade Poster Contest.

Mother Lode Dispatch Editor Tom Adams reported there were eleven issues of the Mother Lode Dispatch distributed in 2019.

Compatriot Don Littlefield inquired if the Chapter had a web page. Compatriot Tierney replied he was in the process of getting one started. Compatriot Littlefield offered his help with a one page "go-daddy" web page for the chapter. Compatriot Tierney mentioned he was looking into a Google web page.

New Business: Compatriot Conover contacted the El Dorado County Sheriff's Department and the Placerville Police Department regarding the Chapter's Community Awards Banquet. He reported both departments were disappointed the Banquet was not held in 2019. There was some discussion as to what departments we should send invitations to for nominations for awards. It was decided the list should be limited to four departments. The Sheriff's Office, Placerville Police, and CHP were quickly decided on. Other departments that were discussed were the area fire departments, State Park Rangers, and Public Service Dispatchers. It was noted the area fire departments had not been responsive to our invitations recently. It may be due to the unusual schedule of the members of that community. The State Parks Rangers had recently been recognized so it was decided to invite a Public Service Dispatcher to our next Banquet.

Mother Lode Chapter Meeting Minutes, February 25, 2020 Denny's Restaurant, Cameron Park, CA

The meeting was called to order by Executive Vice President Sam Bradley at 6:40 PM. Compatriot Bradley gave the Invocation, guest and future Chapter member Randall Keith led the Pledge of Allegiance, and Compatriot Bob Conover led the SAR Pledge.

There were six members, **Steve Almy, Sam Bradley, Bob Conover, Tom Douglas, Kevin Tierney**, Duel Member **Tom Chilton** and two guests **Marilyn Chilton** and **Randall Keith** in attendance.

Compatriot Bradley welcomed the guests and the minutes of the January 28, 2020 minutes were approved.

Youth Activities Coordinator, Kevin Tierney reported there were six entries for the Brochure Contest, one from Rolling Hills Middle School and five from Camerado Middle School. The NSSAR Americanism Committee is considering limiting entrants for the Brochure Contest to seventh, eighth, and ninth grades. Sixth grades are now able to participate in the contest. John Adams Academy did not participate this year in the Brochure Contest but will have entries in the Poster Contest. Rob Flowers will be presented the Silver Good Citizenship Medal for being selected the 2019 SAR Outstanding Teacher. The medal will be presented to Mr. Flowers at the CASSAR Spring Meeting in Rancho Murieta in April by California Society President Robert Taylor.

Treasurer Bob Conover reported a bank balance of \$3,962. Secretary Douglas mentioned he received a letter from RVNA Insurance Brokers for renewal of a policy and asked if the treasurer was aware of the policy or the costs. Treasurer Conover was not, secretary Douglas said he would call the Agent's number on the letter to find out more about the policy.

Secretary Douglas asked for assistance in wording the preliminary letters he was going to send to the organizations the Chapter was going to invite to the awards banquet. He received a couple of suggestions and said he would get the letters mailed out soon.

The Benediction was given, the SAR Recessional recited and after the singing of "God Bless America" the meeting was adjourned at 7:15 PM
