The Passing of One of the Chapter's Founders: Thomas Hobert Chilton, Jr.

The **Sacramento Chapter,** Sons of the American Revolution, hosted a Dinner Meeting celebrating the life of **Tom Chilton** on Wednesday evening, January 19, 2022 at <u>The Old Spaghetti Factory in Sacramento</u>.

Tom was a 28-year member of the SAR, joining the Sacramento Chapter in 1993. He served as President of the Sacramento Chapter for 5 years: 2000, 2001, 2002, 2004, and 2012. He was chapter Registrar for more than a decade. Tom also served as Registrar for the California Society from 2008 through 2011. In addition, he was a founding member of the Mother Lode Chapter in 2008.

Tom Douglas and my wife Anne and I attended from the Mother Lode Chapter. A lot was said about this incredible man. But the comment that impressed me the most – because it revealed one very important reason why we all admired this man – was made by his beloved wife, Marilyn. She said the unique quality that Tom had was that he embraced <u>all</u> of the Goals of the SAR: Honoring the Past; Recognizing those who Share our Values;

and Educating our Youth. When she said that it hit home because that does not fit me. I am primarily focused on just one SAR goal, Youth Education.

Marilyn was right. Her Tom was the model of what an SAR compatriot should be. He was a Chapter Officer, and a State Officer. He was in his Chapter's Color Guard, and a key member of their 'School Guard' education program. And he would cold-call on a school to promote the Chapter's School Guard program, or a State's youth program.
