Subject: Essay Judges Needed

Compatriots,

I am writing to you to ask if you might be interested in judging essay submissions for the Knight Essay Contest this year. The judging has two phases and you can participate in one, both, or decline entirely. The phases will be as follows:

Phase 1: We need to judge the 4 essays submitted directly to me as the state chair of the contest. The essays need to be read and judged on historical accuracy, clarity of thought, organization and proven topic, grammar and spelling, documentation, and adherence to the contest rules. You will receive a copy of the contest rules and a form on which to rank the 4 essays; 1 being the best and 4 the worst. This needs to be completed no later than January 28th.

Phase 2: We need to judge the winners from the chapters who submit essays, which will include the winner from phase 1 of our judging. The process will be the same for judging these essays and will produce our CASSAR winner that will be forwarded to the national competition. This judging will take place in February.

Please let me know at your earliest convenience if you would be interested in judging phase 1, phase 2, both or neither. Once I hear from you, if you are interested, I will forward the essays, rules, and judging form.

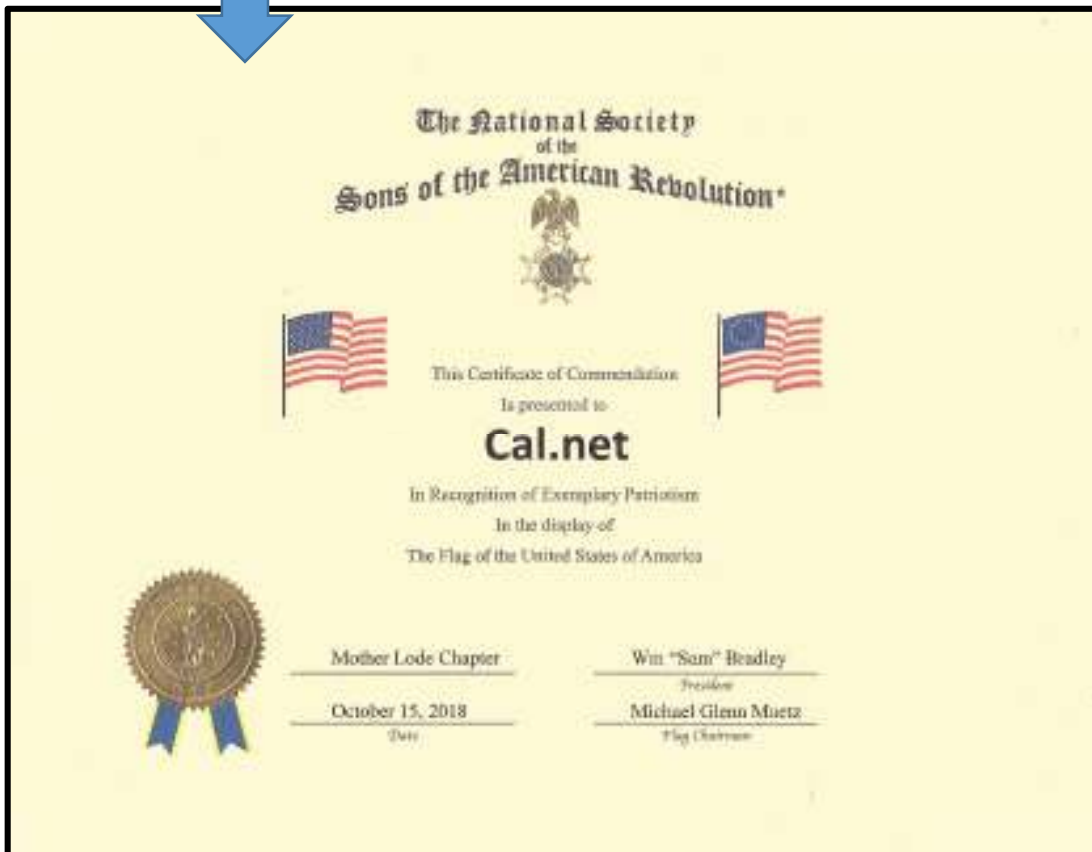
Mother Lode Chapter's Flag Certificate Presentation
