
From the Mother Lode President

Reports:

Presidents Report -

Tom reported that we did not have an Executive Committee Meeting this past month, but we did conduct business via phone, text messages, emails and conversations.

Tom made reference to a *Dispatch* article regarding the need for donations. He reminded the Chapter that we cannot survive without donations.
