Hello Friends:

Our sister group, the Daughters of the American Revolution, (**DAR**), are helping the French government in a project they are working on called The Lafayette Trail. It is a reenactment of the tour made in 1824 by the Marquis de Lafayette to commemorate the victory of the Americans who fought the English in the Revolutionary War, in which Lafayette participated. He visited all the original 13 colonies. In each visit the state's governor or mayor of the capital city came to meet Lafayette, and thousands of other dignitaries and state leaders, as well as bands and choruses, came to the capital to greet Lafayette. In Rhode Island, when Lafayette was ascending the capital steps, he happened to see my ancestor Stephen Olney, a Revolutionary War hero and a personal friend of Lafayette's from the war years, and breaking away from the planned ceremonies Lafayette turned aside and ran over and embraced Stephen Olney. The crowd cheered, the band played. Later many people wrote about the incident, saying, "There was not a dry eye among the thousands who witnessed this event." So in 2024 the French government is planning on having a Frenchman, dressed correctly and playing Lafayette, reenact the trip by visiting all of the state capitals.
