🕒 Annual Boiler Servicing.

Annual boiler servicing, service booklet completion or the issuance of a service sheet in the absence of a service booklet.

🕒🕒 Boiler, Central Heating System & Controls.

Your boiler, central heating system & controls (Excluding batteries) shall be checked for safe operation along with the TRV's and lock-shields connected to the radiators.

🕒🕒🕒 Emergency Call-Outs.

Free emergency breakdown call-outs for your boiler, central heating system & controls.

🕒🕒🕒🕒 Faults, Diagnosis or Repair.

Our heating engineers are experts in what they do and so shall endeavour to help you out ASAP over the phone with minor issues such as a boiler reset, pressurisation or isolation, should a more serious issue be suspected by the engineer' they shall attend your property the very same day or for less serious issues' within 24 hours, the Vulnerable or elderly persons and house-holds living with Children under 5 years shall always be prioritised.

🕒🕒🕒🕒🕒 Emergency Electrical Heating & Hot Water Units.

Often boiler breakdowns require new serviceable parts such as a pump, fan, gas valve or circuit board to name just a few and in many cases these have to be ordered' so in situations like this pflushpro shall provide a least (1x) temporary electric water heater' suitable for hand washing and low water usage along with up-to (2x) electric heaters.

🕒🕒🕒🕒🕒🕒 Power Flushing Required?

If your central heating system requires power flushing after your first full year of Warm Cover or your Warm Cover plan is paid in full as a one-off payment' then Power Flushing shall be carried out for a flat fee of just £249.00 Inc VAT for up-to 8 radiators, additional radiators shall be charged pro-rata @ £15.00 Inc VAT each in addition to the fixed priced power flushing.
