## CITY ORDINANCE

8-1-77

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CAMP WOOD, PROHIBITING THE SALE, OFFERING FOR SALE, EXPOSING FOR SALE, USE, OR DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF SAID CITY; AND PROVIDING A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN ~~TWO~~ <sup>FIVE</sup> HUNDRED DOLLARS (~~\$200.00~~ <sup>500.00</sup>) FOR ANY VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMP WOOD, TEXAS:


Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, offer or expose for sale, possess for the purpose of sale, use, discharge, or cause to be discharged, ignited, fired, or otherwise set in action within the limits of the city any fireworks, fire crackers, rockets, sparklers, torpedos, Roman candles, fire balloons, or other substances of any combination whatsoever, designed or intended for pyrotechnic display.

Section 2. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction be fined not more than ~~Two~~ <sup>FIVE</sup> Hundred Dollars (~~\$200.00~~ <sup>500.00</sup>).
