




BOOK SALE THIS WEEKEND - Sept. 30


Join us for Meet and Greet Oct. 2 - Next Week!

Janette Spiezio, owner of the business, who is also a seamstress, greeted us in a cotton dress she made herself with cotton thread and in Birkenstocks because, on untreated grass, she would rather be barefoot. So would I. Janette is passionate about removing all toxins from our food, clothing and environment.

After a brief but very informative presentation about her history and her business, Janette taught us to make our own organic cleaning solution in our very own glass spray bottle. It was fun. We took our newly made solution home and it works great!

We also took a tour of the shop where we found lots of not-so-exotic products like a rock deodorant, cotton instead of paper towels, and salon quality bars of shampoo or conditioner, for a plastic-free existence, to name just a few of her products. If we each only eliminated one shampoo bottle, we would be contributing hundreds fewer plastic bottles to the landfill every year. Did you know that only 9% of what we try to recycle actually gets recycled? It may be a baby step but it all adds up. Can't wait to see where the next field trip takes us.
