



DID YOU KNOW?

More than 2,000 trees are usually planted per acre. On an average 1,000-1,500 of these trees will survive. Almost all trees require shearing to attain the Christmas tree shape. At six to seven feet, trees are ready for harvest. It takes six to ten years of fighting heavy rain, wind, hail and drought to get a mature tree.



RED VELVET PANCAKES WITH CREAM CHEESE GLAZE

These beautiful pancakes are bright red in color with a hint of chocolate topped with cream cheese glaze and chocolate sprinkles make for a very decadent breakfast or brunch!



PANCAKES: 1 1/4 c. all-purpose flour; 2 c. red velvet cake mix; 1 T. granulated sugar; 3/4 tsp. baking powder; Pinch of salt; 2 lg. eggs; 1 tsp. vanilla extract; 2 c. milk, divided

CREAM CHEESE FROSTING: 4 oz. cream cheese, softened; 1/4 c. butter, softened; 1 tsp. vanilla extract; 2 c. confectioners' sugar; 2-3 T. milk, more if needed

TOPPINGS: Chocolate Jimmies for sprinkling; Red sugar sprinkles if desired

1. PANCAKES: Whisk together all ingredients except for 1 cup milk. Add remaining milk a 1/4 cup at a time until you've reached your desired pancake consistency (thinner batter for thinner pancakes, thicker batter for thicker pancakes).

2. Heat a griddle or skillet over medium heat. Coat with butter or spray with cooking spray. Once the pan is hot, ladle 1/4 cupfuls of batter onto the pan and cook until bubbles start to form on the top, about 1 to 2 minutes. Flip over and cook another 1 to 2 minutes or until light brown. Repeat with the remainder of the batter.

3. CREAM CHEESE FROSTING: Beat together the cream cheese and butter until smooth. Add vanilla and confectioners' sugar one cup at a time, beat until smooth. Add milk 1 tablespoon at a time until you've reached desired consistency. Drizzle frosting over pancakes and top with chocolate sprinkles. Serves 10-12

4. NOTE: For an extra special treat, sprinkle pancakes with semisweet chocolate chips before turning.




