Subject: Tech & Dress Rehearsals at the theater for the Beauty & the Beast Cast!

We are so excited about our Spring Ballet "Beauty & the Beast" on Sunday, May 5.

The following rehearsals and the show will be held at the **War Memorial Convention Hall**, located at 4191 Hardy St, Lihue.

TECH REHEARSAL:

Friday, May 3

3:30pm Call Time - Full Cast, including Ballet I (*Beg Ballet & Ballet/Tap classes do not come*)
3:30-4:00 Warm Up
4:00-4:15 Get into costume
4:15-6:00 Tech rehearsal
6:00-6:30 Dinner break - (*Ballet 1 & Ballet 1/2 dismissed*)
6:30-8:30 Work Act 3 (*Gaston - Attack - Transformation*)

- Students should arrive backstage in dance attire, dance footwear (ballet, jazz or athletic) and with full hair and makeup done.
- Bring all costumes. You can leave in the theater for the weekend.
- Parents should drop off and come back (at 6:00 or 8:30pm) to pick up students.
- There is a separate event in the lobby on May 3 - all entrances should be through the backstage door.
- No food or drink is allowed inside of the theatre. All food brought for dinner and lunch must be in sealed containers (the ants are bad in the theater!) and placed on the food table backstage.

- Students should arrive backstage in dance attire, dance footwear (ballet, jazz or athletic) and with full hair and makeup done.
- Parents may watch the 12:30pm dress rehearsal from the audience. Please enter through the lobby.
- We encourage you to take photos & videos during rehearsal time.

- Students should arrive in full hairstyle & makeup at the backstage door. Beginning Ballet, Ballet/Tap and Ballet I should arrive in costume.

SHOWS:

- Lobby and Theater doors will open 30 minutes prior to show time.

TICKETS:

- Tickets are on sale online now for \$15 each (\$20 at the door if still available).
- Priority seating is available for \$30 each (first 4-5 rows of the theater).
- Purchase tickets ASAP as this show will sell out.
- All tickets must be purchased in the office or online [here](#) or from your parent portal.

- Parents, siblings & friends (age 4+) will need a ticket. The dancer does not need a ticket.
