"JUMP is proud to be the largest dance convention in the world, touring to 27 US cities and 3 international cities. A typical convention weekend lasts from Friday afternoon to Sunday afternoon and is jam-packed with all things DANCE! Each event includes a top-rate workshop in numerous styles of dance: Jazz, Tap, Ballet, Contemporary, Hip-Hop, Jazz Funk, Musical Theater, Lyrical and Ballroom. JUMP also offers a first-class competition with fair, credible judging in a fun and supportive environment. The weekend concludes with a fantastic closing show, scholarship presentations and faculty performances! JUMP's mission is to have dancers of all ages and levels return to their dance studio feeling more motivated and inspired!"

WORKSHOP vs COMPETING:

- Attending JUMP is a big investment into your child's dance training!
- If this is their first year attending JUMP, they may want to simply attend the workshops offered that weekend, and observe the competition.
- If they are experienced in performing and competing (Jazz Level 2+), they may opt to audition to be a part of a competition team, solo, duo or trio.
- JUMP bases age categories by the age that students are on January 1, 2024. Whatever age you were on that date, that's the age category you'll be placed for competition and workshop classes.

COST:

- We've included a thorough price sheet for the various options.
- If you are on the Dance House Master Plan, your Group Piece Rehearsals are Free.
- Students are responsible for travel expenses, room, board & supervision before and after workshops.
- Dance House staff members will be present with the students during workshop classes & competition.
- If a parent is unable to fly to Oahu and your child needs supervision for the entire weekend, please let us know and we will see if the student can buddy-up with another attendee.
- The prices listed are based on JUMP's Early Bird Pricing. All JUMP fees must be paid by March 31, 2024 so that we can submit them before the Early Bird Deadline.
- Team jackets are \$50 and are required for those on the Competition Team. Jackets are optional for those attending the workshop.
- Parents & Students are encouraged to fundraise! Garage Sales, Movie Nights, Bake Sales.

OBSERVATION:

- In order to go into the workshops to observe, parents must purchase an observer band. It's \$55 ahead of time, or \$65 on-site. For Jump-Start (ages 5-7), the observer band is \$40 and only available on-site.
- The public is allowed to watch the competitions.

Held on Friday, January 26, 2024 at Lihue Dance House in Kukui Grove across from Deli & Bread:

- 4:45-5:45 Intermediate Audition for ages 8-12 (Jazz level 2 or higher)
- 5:45-6:45 Open House Meet & Greet Answer questions
- 6:45-7:45 Advanced Audition for ages 12-18 (Jazz level 3 or higher)
- 7:45-8:30 Tap Audition - Intermediate & Advanced

If you cannot attend the audition, please fill out an audition form and turn it in by Thursday, January 25.

Special consideration may be given to current Koloa Dance House Company Members to compete with a piece from their 2023-24 season if enough students attend the audition.
