## **Swimming Pool Opening Procedures**

<b>_</b>	cover.
	Remove the cover from the pool, then clean thoroughly and fan fold neatly, and put it away.
	Install all fixtures such as, lights, handrails & ladders, diving boards, rope & float set, return eyes, skimmer baskets, etc.
	Brush down walls & floors, dip out all leaves possible, brush and clean the steps thoroughly.
	Clean the scum line along the tile border of the pool.
	Reinstall all plugs, gauges, sight glasses, backwash hoses, bleeder screws, chlorinators, and any other filter system components prior to starting system.
	Start the filter system and repair any minor leaks if possible, making sure that all unions, valves, and any hose connections are secure.
	Take a water sample, always before adding the start-up chemicals.
	Add the necessary start-up chemicals if the filter is running, if not, leave the chemicals in the customers possession.
	Make a note of any repairs that may need to be done.
	Start the water running slowing back into the pool with the customer's garden hose if needed.
	Tell the customer about any problems with the pool if they are present or leave the customer a note, where he/she can find it, stating any problems with the pool & that the water is running into the pool and should be checked upon their returning.
