We are not responsible for students before or after the summer program hours. Please be courteous of and respect other students' personal property. Students should be picked up promptly after the summer program has finished for the day. For safety reasons, no student will be allowed outside into the parking lot unless accompanied by an adult. If the coordinator or instructors are waiting for an extended period of time you will be billed accordingly. Enrollment is made at the Coordinator's discretion. Cornerstone Christian Academy, ViewFinder, and the Instructors are not liable for personal injuries or loss or damage to personal property. Please inform an instructor of any physical limitations which may prevent full participation in the summer program.
