Three Ways to Vote

- 1. In person on election day: A person that is not registered can register and vote same day. Polling hours are 8am to 8pm. This date is May 21st.
- 2. In person absentee: These dates are from May 6th to May 17th during normal business hours at the Adams County Courthouse, Clerk's Office. In this circumstance a person comes in, requests a ballot, receives an absentee ballet, votes in a private room, and turns the ballot in.
- 3. Absentee by mail. Absentee by mail requests can be made now on-line at www.voteidaho.gov or by printing out the Absentee Ballot Application Form from the same website or the Adams County Website at www.co.adams.id.us, filling it out and mailing it to the Adams County Courthouse at PO Box 48, Council, ID 83612 or dropping it off at the Clerk's Office at the courthouse. The last day to request an absentee ballot be mailed to you is May 10th. The absentee by mail ballot can either be returned by mail or delivered in person at the courthouse, but must be received no later than Election Day (May 21st) at 8:00 P.M.
