Shirt Colors

Kindergarten - Grade 5: Light Blue, Navy, & Gold. Grade 6 - Grade 8: Red, Grey, & Hunter Green. Grade 9 - Grade 12: Red, Grey, Black, & Hunter Green.

Uniform Pants/Skirts

Pants and skirts may be purchased from various retailers and uniform stores.

Girls: Young ladies in all grade levels must wear skirts at **knee length** with an appropriate fit at the waist. **Boys:** Young men in all grade levels are to wear appropriately fitted pants at waist level with pant length past the ankle. A belt must be worn **daily**. Joggers, cargos, and denim pants are **not** permitted.

Uniform Pants/Skirts Colors

Kindergarten - Grade 5: Navy Blue & Black. Grade 6 - Grade 12: Navy Blue, Khaki, & Black.

Shoes

All learners are permitted to wear boats, loafers, and dress shoes (black and brown only). Learners may **not** wear shoes with open toes or exposed heels. Sneakers are only allowed for physical education (PE).

Jackets/Sweaters

The only permitted jackets and sweaters are the official HTCA outerwear purchased via our uniform store. **During temperatures lower than 70 degrees**, all styles of outerwear are acceptable. Additionally, during colder months, thermal shirts and tights may be worn with uniform attire. **Thermal shirt and tight colors must align with our uniform colors.**

Hair

All hair is to be neatly groomed **daily**. Extravagant hairstyles are **not** permitted. All hair **must** be a natural color.

<u>Jewelry</u>

It is suggested that all learners refrain from wearing excessive jewelry, as we are **not** responsible for the loss or damage of these items.

Backpacks/Purses

Only clear/transparent backpacks and purses are permitted for the 2023/2024 academic year.
