Her passion for her subject and the perfection of her craft has since made her one of the most esteemed botanical artists in Canada.

In 1979 the Federation of Canadian Artists recognized her remarkable talent by electing her to the status of A.F.C.A.; then only 20, she was the youngest yet to receive that honour. For the past three decades, Caren has been enthusiastically received in solo and group shows across North America, and with the Royal Society of Painters in Miniature in London, England. She has also exhibited in touring shows throughout Canada, the United States and Europe; sponsored by the Government of British Columbia, The University of British Columbia, the Federation of Canadian Artists, the Susan Kathleen Black Foundation and the Canadian Nature Federation.

A love of detail and design has led Caren to apply her considerable talent to other artistic pursuits. She is an experienced muralist and illustrator, who has fulfilled a number of commissions for commercial art and advertising placements. The Royal Canadian Mint also selected Caren's artwork for two limited edition gold coins in a series depicting Canada's provincial flowers; the Pacific Dogwood to represent British Columbia and Mountain Avens for the Northwest Territories.

Caren is much sought-after as a teacher for classes and workshops, and the educational painting tours she has hosted with her internationally renowned father and brother for the past two decades. The architecture and flora of these new destinations continue to inspire her and take her paintings in new directions.
