The following is an update on activities involving our Parks and Recreation Department this month.

Youth Soccer – With the beautiful weather we have been experiencing lately everything is on schedule and we should complete this season around October 21st.

Flag (fall) Football – Interest in this second year program remains strong and we should complete registration on Friday, October 6th.

Youth Girls Volleyball – Registration for this well-established program concludes Thursday, October 5th.

Hinson Lake – This past weekend (Sept. 29th – Oct. 1st) our facility hosted its 17th annual ultra marathon race that has become a staple for many of these long distance runners.

The first race was held in 2006 and had 68 participants. This year's totals are in and there were 418 runners which represents an all-time high.
