I pray this message finds you all well in our uncertain times. This has truly been a challenging year for all of us but I am so happy to report that we were finally able to bring a small mission team to Haiti for Easter. This was a long awaited trip as we had to cancel last year due to the pandemic. Flights are finally open and although there are still travel concerns 6 of us decided to make this trip. It was such a blessing for us to be able to be a part of this mission trip. As usual the kids were so happy to see us and we were overjoyed to spend some time sharing the love of Jesus with them all. The team took part in our MHM classes and visited 2 of our partner sites. We hosted a youth color blast rally on Easter Sunday and rejoiced! We visited neighbors in the community and shared about Jesus's light while delivering solar lights to those without electricity. We provided 16 families and 2 Orphanages with home water filter kits. We completed many projects around the mission house and upgraded solar power, added a sink, food prep table and shelving to organize supplies. We had training with our staff and community partners and worked on communication and team building skills. We all left a piece of heart with the kids there and we even left Missionary Sarah there for another extended stay. She will be hosting an in depth "I believe in Jesus" class for the older kids and an English class along with several other activities. It was such a blessed trip and we felt the prayers that were going out for us. But what I did not expect to find out was just how truly important mission teams are.

We often think that short term trips can't have much impact but everywhere we went I was reminded by the locals just how much hope short term mission teams bring. We were told over and over that we were the first group in this area in the past year and we saw the effects that not having groups were having in Haiti. Groups bring encouragement and hope to many who so often feel hopeless and forgotten. Many businesses and even mission organizations were closed due to the lack of groups visiting and bringing support. Local artists rely on groups to purchase their art as their sole revenue. So yes! Mission groups are vital to sharing the love of Jesus and bringing the hope that only He can deliver. Because of your support we are able to continue our children's class and community projects even during these times.
