Carnival Season has passed, and that means one very important thing in the South. CRAWFISH, MUDBUGS, CRAYFISH. Whatever you call it, that mud castle making feisty red delicacy is BACK and so are WE, for seconds of the now annual Best of Baldwin Boil.

Entry Fee is \$250, partial payment will be accepted with a requirement of full payment on or before April 10, 2023.. Payments collected will be used for Order, Transport & Care of live crawfish. All ingredients outside of this are the responsibility of the enrolled team.

Let's get to the DETAILS. Any and all equipment pertaining to cooking the crawfish is on the team and is mandatory for this event and backup propane is strongly suggested. (Pots, Spices, Tables, Chairs, etc.) Tents are strongly suggested but not mandatory. Event host will have crawfish delivered prior to the start of the event, iced, purged and distributed upon the START time of cook-off. We may require a cooler to be dropped prior to the event to suffice the distribution portion of the event to run smoothly and fairly to all cooking teams. Please consider any prep work required and proceed with consideration to any special requirements. Teams are welcome and encouraged to display, share, sell and showcase any background info, products and/or merchandise for the duration of the event. If possible, teams are encouraged, but not required, to complete "set up" in their designated or chosen (details TBA after final number of team entries is determined) prior to day of or start of event to ensure a smooth unfolding for both the hosts, teams, guests, vendors, pickers, etc.

This year's time and location (within the farm property) is currently TBA but projected sites are, again on the hill/amphitheater or in the Monet Garden that houses the partially enclosed, fully powered barn, a separate small section dedicated to children's activities and play, and also a raised, covered stage. Chairs & blankets are suggested for when the event turns over to the musical performance.

We are adding Vendors/Makers/Crafters to the roster of the event and Grits & Greens (Mobile hometown band) will close the day out with a performance on one of the two stages with a start time of 6.30pm and a perceived end time between 8.30pm/9pm.

In an effort to reduce traffic, carbon footprint and safety among ourselves and this peaceful

area, we encourage teams to carpool if possible. A section of the parking lot will be reserved for Muscle/Classic/Antique and Unique Vehicles as well as Motorcycle Enthusiasts to socialize and showcase. It will be open to the public for gazes, glares, photos and jaw drops the entirety of the event.

Words cannot express how enthusiastic we are to have this event a second year! We hope to see returning & new teams, all of our farm friends and neighbors, and lots of new faces as well that become friends by the end of the day. For the returning teams - all construction is finished and the Siloh's will be in Open House mode to attendees. "Block 12" outside of the Monet Garden will be bursting with color and flavor of all varieties, which, of course, we hope includes the first crop of Blueberries to be harvested this year. ## **Team/Host Agreement**

Teams/registrants will pay to Weeks Bay Plantation of Fairhope the amount of either \$250 US dollars, either in full, or in portions noted to Staff (Heather or Tynes) hereafter, with the amount paid in full on or before April 10, 2023.

Hosts(WBP) will order the expected amount of crawfish ready and delivered on or before the day of event, April 15, 2023. WBP is responsible for distribution to teams on the event date.

Team/registrant shall have a designated space for trash in the team area and keep a tidy space throughout the event, while WBP provides public garbage cans and facilities for recycling, restroom use and hand washing.

Teams may involve up to 6 members at their registry cost of \$250, with their children and spouses at no extra cost for the event.

Teams are permitted to sell, advertise any personal merchandise to the attendees during the event.

WBP will announce a time and location on the farm for which the event is to begin, when registrants are expected to set up, arrive and break down when a final registrant count is made. All information pertaining to location is the responsibility of the host.

WBP will establish a voting system in which the winner is determined by both a licensed food critic as well as a popular crowd vote.

WBP is not responsible for any injury suffered by the teams members or families at the cause of any circumstance that takes place in the teams area or by their equipment.

Team/registrant acknowledges all risks related to outdoor activities on the ground of WBP, and agrees to conduct themselve(s) in a friendly, professional manner to its team members, other team members, staff and attendees through the entirety of event.
