Entry fees (Money Orders or Cashier's Checks Only) in the correct amount, must accompany entry form. Absolutely no refunds for any reason after May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2024. No Personal Checks!

- 2. Contestants must be 6-18 years old as of January 1, 2024. Copy of Birth Certificate and Entry with

  Parents/Legal Guardian or Contestant (if 18) Notarized signature or copy of Driver's License must accompany each entry. If not, entry will be returned. Birth Certificate will be returned when picking up numbers.

- 4. There will be an office charge of 15% on any entries returned.
