AGE ELIGIBILITY:

Players graduating in 2024-2028 are eligible for play in the 2024 Legion Softball season.

ALL-STAR RECOGNITION:

All-Star recognition for the top 12 players in the state will be held on August 10-11, 2024.

All-Star players are nominated by their coaches.

August 10, 2024 there will be a banquet and recognition.
