The current eight-regional format was adopted by American Legion Baseball in 1960. From 1943 to 1959, 12 four-team regionals were held with the winners advancing to four three-team sectionals. The sectional champions would advance to the American Legion World Series. From 1926 to 1942, district/regional champions would advance to a regional, with the two regional champions meeting in a best-of-five series for the national championship. Hosts did not receive an automatic berth into any national tournaments until about 1970.
