



## **Powder Basin Equestrian Association**

## What is Working Equitation?

While the discipline can consist of 4 phases (dressage trial, ease of handling, speed trial, and cattle trial) the clinic will focus on ease of handling introduction to introduce the horses to the obstacles as well as instruct you on how you and your horse can succeed in this phase. **This discipline is open to both English and western riders looking for something fun and challenging.**
