The Home Health Care Aide will work under the support and supervision of the Health Manager. The Home Health Care Aide will provide assistance and instruction in managing and maintaining home care where needed.

General Duties:

- Work in cooperation with other community agencies and service providers on and off reserve
- Medication reminders, wound care, and medication equipment pick up
- Footcare bookings
- Support to adult day programs, client pick up/drop off and providing rides to and from medical appointments
- Emotional support, wellness visits and mental health checks
- Local shopping for food and other household necessities
- Charting on clients, case management, and advocating on behalf of client
- Palliative care and reporting to nurse of any changes in clients
